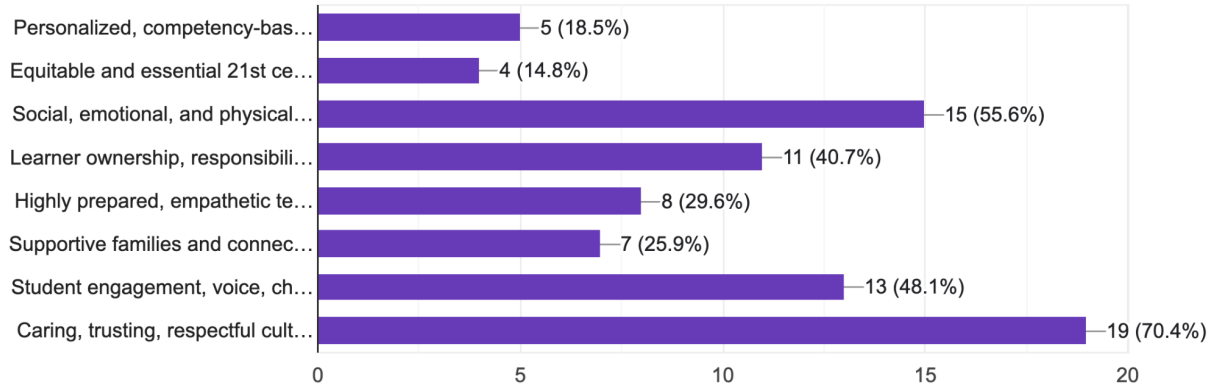

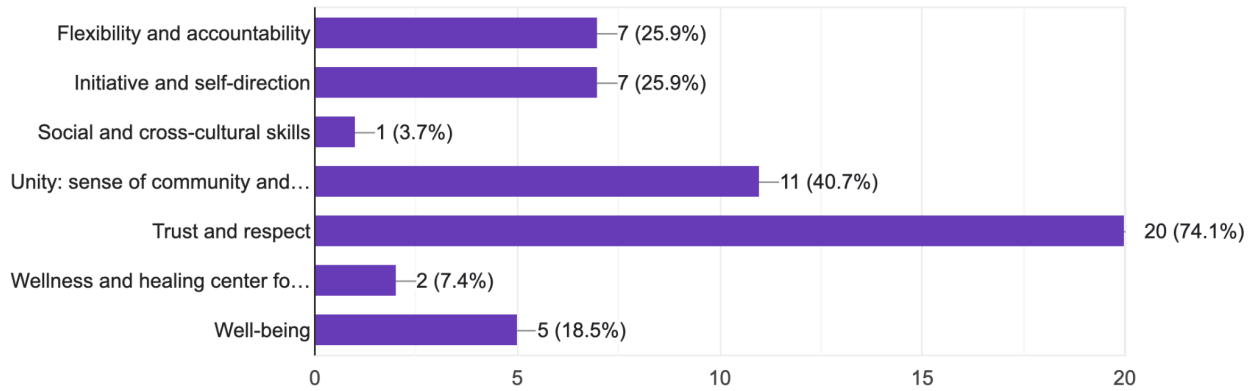

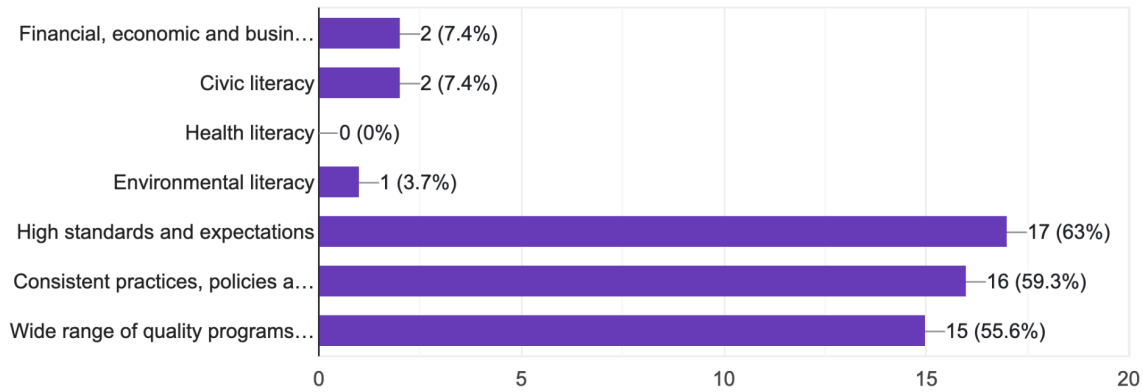
Check two PERSONAL characteristics that you like best for a District Portrait.

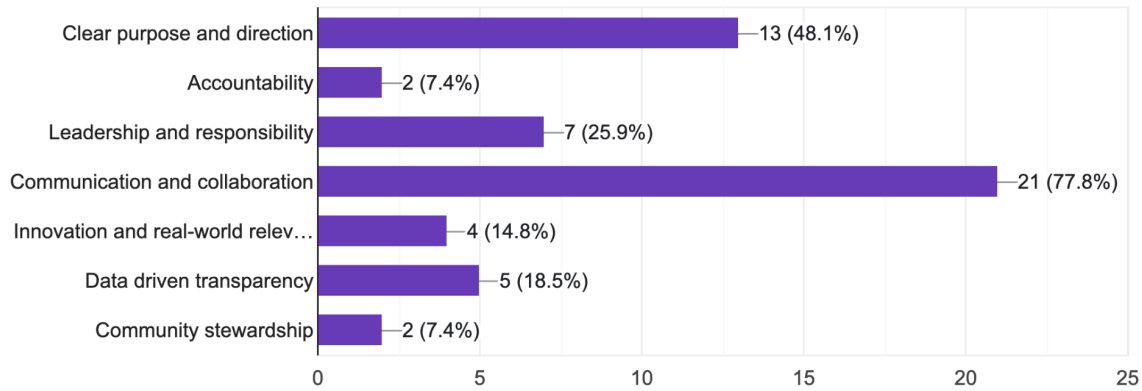

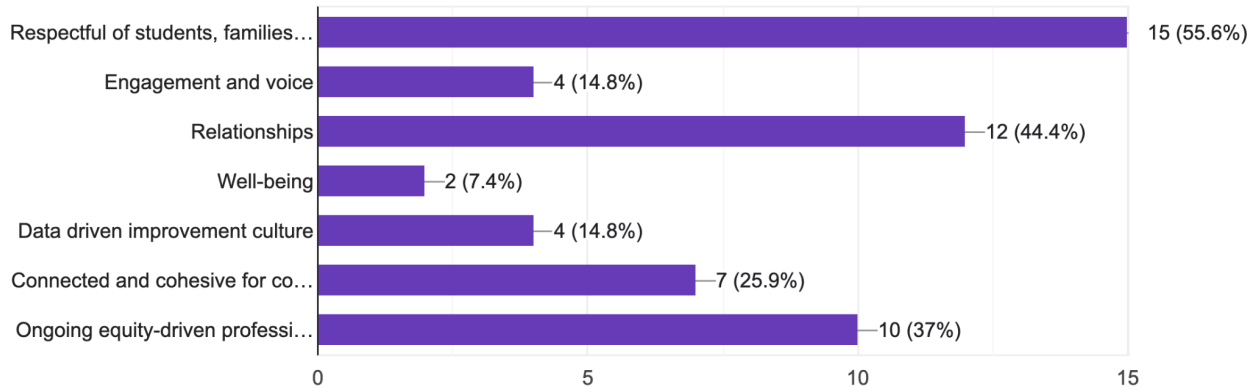
Check two WORKPLACE characteristics that you like best for a District Portrait.

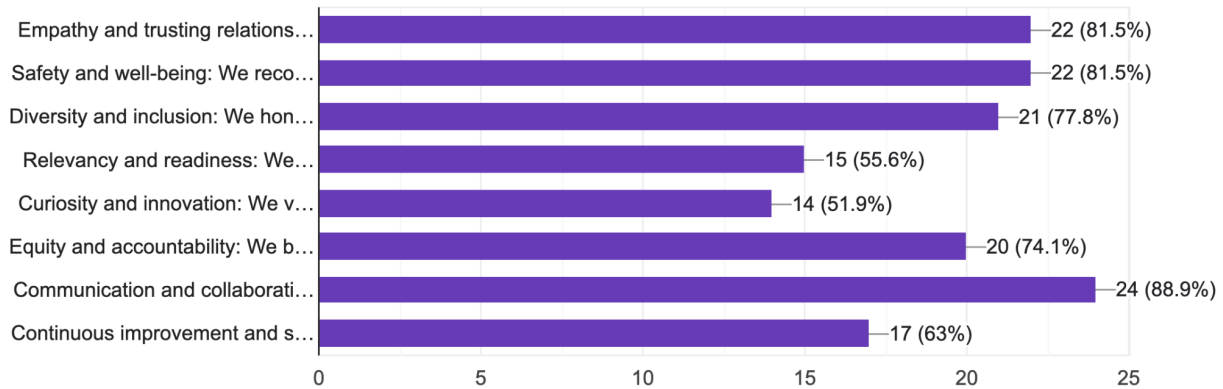
