Returning Students

This process is to make sure the district has updated information for your student prior to the start of the school year. If you are a new student at Magnolia ISD and you already completed the registration process, you do not need to complete this verification.

Childcare Programs



Magnolia ISD offers a variety of childcare services including Early Morning

Childcare, our After School Adventures Program, and employee daycare. These programs are designed to provide a fun and safe environment while keeping the best interests of the child, parents, and family in mind. Each program has a separate enrollment process, along with specific guidelines for the program.



Early Morning

The Early Morning Childcare Program is open to students at our elementary and intermediate campuses beginning at 6:30 a.m. on regular school days at no cost. Students attending must be enrolled.

Adventures After School

The After School Adventures Program provides a healthy blend of fun, meaningful, and adventurous activities to keep them engaged during their time after school. The program is available to all Magnolia ISD students in grades pre-k through 6 at all elementary campuses until 6:30 p.m.

My SchoolBucks

Parents can create a mySchoolBucks® account to pre-pay for their student's meals, snacks, and a la carte items. Prepaying for meals helps the lunch lines move faster and gives students more time to eat and relax. It also gives families the peace of mind to not worry about looking for lunch money every day or worrying about it getting lost, stolen, or used for something else.

mySchoolBucks® offers a mobile app to easily manage your child's account. Through the app or on the mySchoolBucks® website, parents can create multiple student accounts, receive "low balance" notifications, see a history of what items have been purchased, and much more. Transportation

Bus routes for the 2023 - 2024 school year will be available in early August. In order to view your child's bus route, visit Versatrans e-Link which can be found on our website.

Through the Versatrans My Stop® mobile app, parents can track their students' bus locations and arrival times, as well as receive notifications on delays. Parents can use a mobile device, tablet, or desktop to view this information through a web browser.
