
ZOOM Instructions

Zoom is a virtual conferencing program that will allow us to stay connected with our students. We'll be able to see and talk to each other.

The teacher will set up the meeting and send you the Meeting ID and password (if applicable.) You can use Zoom with a computer, laptop, tablet, or phone. Follow these instructions if you have not used it before:

Computer/Laptop

Go to www.zoom.us and click "Join a Meeting." Then type in the meeting ID and password. You may be prompted to allow audio and video (this lets us hear and see your child through the webcam.) If you don't see anything at first, give it a few minutes because you may be in the virtual waiting room until the meeting officially begins.




Tablet/Phone

You'll need to download the app. Then, click on "Join" and type in the meeting ID and password. Make sure the audio and video are connected. If you don't see anything at first, give it a few minutes because you may be in the virtual waiting room until the meeting officially begins.



Leave these off so we can see and hear your child.



- 1. If you are having an issue and you can't hear the meeting even after allowing your phone/tablet's audio and camera to join, your phone may have another app that's running in the background using the audio. Try closing out all opened programs. If that doesn't work, try restarting the app or phone to see if that fixes the problem.
- 2. If on a laptop and you don't want the pictures to keep shuffling between people, you can change the setting to see everyone (go to Gallery View in the upper right corner.) This will make it look like the Brady Bunch. If you want to focus on the presenter (go to Speaker View in the upper right corner.) You can focus on a specific person by clicking the picture of the person. You should see 3 dots in the corner. Click those dots and select "pin video."
