GPA

Amity High School has adopted the ABCDF grading system based on the 4.0 scale. Permanent records carry semester grades only. Rank in class & calculated GPA are determined at the end of the most recent semester completed. The Grade Point Average is determined by adding all grade points earned and dividing by the number of graded credits. The GPA is computed at the end of each semester. The cumulative GPA is determined by the average of all grades earned in high school.

A=4 points, B=3 points, C=2 points, D=1 point, F=0 points.

AHS HONORS DIPLOMA

Amity High School honors diploma is an advanced academic benchmark that students can obtain as they complete rigorous courses with academic excellence throughout their 4 years.
