Community Service Planning




- Audrey is leading effort to brainstorm off-campus volunteer ideas via Google spreadsheet with team of interested parents



On-Campus Community Service


•Meet-up Location: Longleaf Center

- Stephanie started in 4th grade this week as the new permanent teacher.
- Board visited classes last week and had a successful visit; plans to repeat this visit again in April
