Title 1
Parent Involvement Policy



The Board of Education realizes the responsibility of the schools to involve parents in the education of their children. Accordingly, the Board firmly supports the Title 1 Program requirement for parent involvement in their child's Title I Program.

The Title I staff will provide opportunities specifically designed to involve parents in all aspects of their child's program. These activities shall include the following:

1. An annual meeting in the fall, to which all parents of participating children are invited, to explain the Title I Program, goals, instructional activities, and parent involvement opportunities.
2. Parents of students in the Title I pull out program will receive a "parent update" during the months in which their child is in Title I.
3. There will be opportunities for parent-teacher conferences to discuss the child's progress and placement.
4. There will be timely responses to all parent recommendations and/or communication.

A Parents' Advisory Committee is formed during the fall each year to perform the following tasks:

1. Provide assistance in the planning, design, and implementation of the district's Title I Program.
2. Provide input to the building Title I staff on ways that the building's program can be strengthened.
3. Provide input on parent involvement activities and assist in the implementation of these activities when appropriate.

Parents from all Title I buildings are invited to be a part of the Parent Advisory Committee so that the committee has representation from each school.
