



# THE 'CORNERSTONE' OF NDA HOCKEY

Notre Dame Academy has been recognized for multiple years throughout the state to have a very successful and dominating hockey program. One that has produced many high level players in leagues such as the USHL, NCAA, AHL and NHL. For the last 17 years, under the helm of Coach Cory McCracken, the Tritons have accomplished over 300 wins, 11 state tournament appearances, two state titles and one impressive undefeated season that included beating a very talented Detroit Catholic Central (who was also undefeated in their home state of Michigan) in the team's annual trip to the MIHL Showcase in Trenton, Michigan. Off the ice, the Triton hockey players have won the Academic Team Award each of the last four years and also hold a year-over-year average of a 3.76 GPA.

News broke the week of July 17, 2023, that Coach McCracken was stepping down as head coach to pursue an assistant coaching position, alongside head coach, close friend and mentor Luke Strand, at Minnesota State University. As the announcement spread throughout our community, there was a lot of chatter about who would be next to lead the Tritons. NDA is very pleased and proud to announce they have hired 20+ year coaching veteran, college hockey player and former Lawrence University coach, Mike Szkodzincki. Mike is a Detroit, MI native and he and his wife, Tori, and their four kids reside in Green Bay. "I couldn't be more thankful for the opportunity to help continue developing the members of Notre Dame hockey on and off the ice. Thank you to Athletic Director, Matt Koenig, and the committee for entrusting me with this group. Coach McCracken and his staff have given their heart and soul to this program. The results speak for themselves, and we will work to emulate what has been done and build upon the successes. It is an absolute honor to be the next head coach for Notre Dame Boys Hockey and a responsibility that I do not take lightly. My family and I are very much looking forward to being a part of the Notre Dame community" said Coach Szkodzincki. Well coach, the feeling is mutual. We're looking forward to it too.

# Alumni Updates




**Tana Koss, NDA 1998**

## Pay it Forward. The Mentor Coaching Program.



In 2018, the 1978 PHS State Football Championship team gathered for their 40th anniversary. As with many anniversary gatherings, the team began to reminisce about the past and their time as Cadets. Many mentioned how the school helped lay out the foundation to which they built their lives upon. They also gave credit to their teachers, coaches and mentors for the lessons they were taught, helping to mold them into who they are today. Members from the team began to stress the importance of passing along these lessons to current NDA students, ensuring they, too, have a strong foundation to build their life upon. Spearheaded by Jim and Sue (Umentum) Ritchay, PHS and SJA 1979 respectively, The Mentor Coaching Program (MCP) was born.

Jim and the members of the 1978 PHS football team raised funding to help with academics, athletics and other extracurricular activities to NDA students who may not have had a chance to participate due to finances or other causes. The mentors, with the support of the NDA Student Services department, are paired up with students, around 20 each academic year, to meet and set a yearly GPA goal. Students are awarded \$500 each semester they reach their target GPA. This award is set aside and accrued during the students' tenure at NDA. Upon graduation, the amount the student receives is applied toward a higher education for tuition, books, room and board, etc.

To make sure students are on track with their goals, and to make sure they are not in need of additional support, the mentor will meet with them, and possibly their teachers, a few times a semester at NDA, and sometimes the mentor will take the student out to dinner or for ice cream.

Mentors are typically alumni of NDA, its predecessor schools, or past parents. Currently there are 11 mentors in the program. As the need for mentorship of students continues to grow, Jim and Sue Ritchay would like to extend an ask for you to join the program and help mentor a student. 



