Graduation Requirements

Each student is required to complete twenty-one (21) credits in order to graduate. Eighteen (18) are required courses while the remaining are student chosen electives. All required courses are rigorous college preparatory coursework taught by a dedicated, dynamic staff. Required units include:

The Humanities at New Albany High School

The humanities are alive and well at NAHS. All New Albany students complete a rigorous Introduction to the Humanities course in their freshman year. This course is a combination of English (1 cr) and social studies (1 cr) which meets 2 periods each day and is co-taught by English and social studies faculty. Students can choose to continue the humanities format in grades 10, 11 and 12 by taking Honors Western Humanities ENG/SS, Intro to American Studies KC/English and Quest for Justice KC/English respectively. The importance of writing, critical thinking, and developing an appreciation for ideas from the past are ingrained into our humanities, English, and social studies curricula. We are committed to an education based in the humanities.
