DISCIPLINE RESPONSE

STEP 1 BEHAVIORS

- *A clear verbal reminder of expectations by Junior Counselor(JC) or Staff directly to the camper.*
 - Being disrespectful or unkind to others
 - Not listening to a JC or staff member
 - Foul language
 - Lying
 - Disrespecting nature or the facilities
 - Throwing objects
 - “Play” fighting and/or pushing (jostling)
 - Disruptive behavior in dormitories including banging on walls, climbing from one top bunk to another, swinging on rafters, etc.
 - Touching or disrupting a camper(s) while sleeping
 - Disruptive or unruly behavior in the Dining Hall or during program activities
 - Inappropriate clothing as described by the *Dress Code* – offensive clothing may be confiscated
 - Intentional exclusion of others

CAMPER RIGHTS: CAMPERS HAVE THE RIGHT TO RELATE THEIR “SIDE OF THE STORY” BEFORE A DISCIPLINARY CONSEQUENCE IS CARRIED OUT.

STEP 2 BEHAVIORS

- *The camper is immediately sent to the summer camp director then:*
 1. *the camper calls home, and*
 2. *the parent and child are warned an imminent dismissal is possible.*
 - Repeat of Step 1 offenses
 - Spitting on another ~~student~~ on anyone
 - Sexual or racial comments and/or references
 - Hate language of any kind (e.g., “gay”, “retarded”, racial slurs)
 - Flashing, mooning, “panting”; and/or exposing one’s genitalia, breasts, or buttocks
 - Acts of physical force and/or pushing forcefully
 - Any prank or joke that makes a camper upset or singles out a camper

STEP 3 BEHAVIORS

- *The camper is immediately sent home.*
 - Repeat of Step 1 or 2 offenses
 - Theft, vandalism, or dorm raiding
 - Harassment such as:
 - opening the stalls of occupied toilets
 - exposing or touching another person’s private area
 - Bullying, intimidation, or violent behavior
 - Possession of or use of tobacco, marijuana, and any drug products or paraphernalia.
 - Deliberate urination or defecation anywhere other than in a toilet
