21f – 50D Virtual Learning Option

Riverview Community School District Families,

We would like to inform you of the procedure that Riverview Community Schools will implement in the event that we have unexpected changes in the school calendar, emergency school closings, standardized testing days, or are in jeopardy of exceeding our allotment of 6 inclement weather days provided by the Michigan Department of Education (MDE).

To ensure that attendance requirements are met, we have established two options for students to complete. These options will be prescribed by their teacher of record. Firstly, students can document their attendance of live synchronous instruction via Microsoft Teams or Zoom. This will provide an opportunity for real-time interaction and engagement with their teachers. Secondly, students can complete a class assignment, lesson, or activity, or access an ongoing lesson. Teachers may post asynchronous material to be completed in Schoology or other means determined by the building administrator.

We appreciate your cooperation and understanding as we navigate these unique circumstances. Our goal is to prioritize the education and well-being of our students, and we are confident that together, we can overcome any obstacles that come our way.

Below are the parameters describing the Virtual Learning Program in the event that such a day is required to be implemented in the Riverview Community School District.

Requirement	50D Virtual Learning
Grades	PreK-12+
Teacher	Teacher of record, including elementary specials teachers
Parent Consent / EDP	Yes – unless virtual is less than 15 days.
Location	Home or 3rd party location
Mode and technological needs of the student	Digital learning environment (online and computer-based learning)
How to distribute technology	Students will be asked to take home their 1:1 device daily once several inclement weather days are used
How the content will be provided	Teachers will post (or email) asynchronous material to the District LMS. The teacher may also have a live zoom with their class and take attendance.
Expectations of the students	Complete the asynchronous assignment or login and participate in the synchronous lesson
Expectation of the teaching staff	Post an asynchronous assignment or host a live synchronous lesson and provide feedback to the students
