Miscellaneous Topics - Mr. Bottini shared information on executive sessions, the mechanics of English and a New York State United Teachers (NYSUT) article on Annual Professional Performance Review (APPR) and Common Core. A suggestion was made by Mr. Nicotera to discuss the superintendent's contract in executive session. Mr. Evans inquired about the process to promote an 8th grader to a varsity sport. Mr. Wheelock explained the selection classification process approved by the New York State Public High School Athletic Association (NYSPHSAA). The process can be initiated by a coach or parent and involves an assessment of one's physical maturation and a physical fitness test in which specified standards are to be met. Mr. Nicotera inquired as to how open houses have gone this fall. Mr. Wheelock shared that they have gone well with the high school open house to take place on Thursday, September 25, 2014, under a new format. Mr. Bottini asked the superintendent about the purpose of the senior meeting on September 25, 2014. Mr. Wheelock explained that the class advisors meet with parents and students to review senior activities (prom, senior trip and graduation); as well as, fundraising campaigns to support these functions. Mr. Mahar will also share the district's expectations of student conduct by seniors, specifically in regard to senior pranks and senior skip day. Mrs. Overrocker shared that there is an open house at Oneida BOCES on Wednesday, October 1, 2014 and there is a college fair at SUNY IT on Tuesday, October 7, 2014.
