Presentation - Mr. Wheelock presented the 2014-15 budget of \$19,510,300 which is an increase of \$628,996 (3.33%). The tax levy will be at the 2% tax limit (1.71%). There are no staff cuts or reduction of programs.

Public to Be Heard - Mrs. Overrocker asked if anyone wished to address the Board and no one did so.

Board Candidates Comments - **Dawn Miller** shared her comments and desire to complete another term as a Board member. She learned a lot during her first term and is looking forward to continuing to serve our school community. **Anthony J. Nicotera** exclaimed that his first term on the Board was nothing like he expected...it was more. He expressed his appreciation for the collaboration and genuine concern for our students and community that the Board displays. He looks forward to another three year term.

Students to Be Heard - Mrs. Overrocker asked if any students wished to address the Board and none did no. No students were present.

Superintendent's Report - Request for Proposal for Audit Services - Mr. Wheelock shared with the Board that despite a slightly higher bid that he is recommending Moore & Hart to continue conducting our school audits. **The Ride for Missing Children** - Mr. Wheelock shared that the Ride will be coming through Sauquoit at 1:00 p.m. on Friday, May 16, 2014. **Board Member Attendance at Graduation** - Mr. Wheelock asked Board members to let him know if they plan on attending the graduation ceremony on Saturday, June 28, 2014.
