The meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m. by Mrs. Miller.

<u>Pledge of Allegiance</u> - The pledge of allegiance was recited.

<u>Presentation</u> - Code of Conduct - Mr. Wheelock informed the Board of the changes being recommended to the Code of Conduct for the 2017-18 school year. A committee of various stakeholders will be convened to get input on the acceptable use policy. The Code of Conduct will be adopted at the August Board meeting.

<u>Public to Be Heard</u> - Mrs. Miller asked if anyone wished to address the Board and no one did so.

<u>Students to Be Heard</u> - Mrs. Miller asked if any students wished to address the Board and none did so. No students were present.

<u>Board of Education Sub-Committee Reports</u> - Facilities and Transportation - Mr. Wheelock said the contractors are moving along on the roofs. The roof by his office is finished and they are still working on the high school roof. A meeting was held with the music department regarding the auditorium and good progress is being made on this. Joe Muller, Supervisor of Safety, Oneida BOCES, toured district facilities to look at the bathrooms/changing areas and made suggestions on how to make these areas private.

<u>Superintendent's Report</u> - 5th Grade Orientation - Mr. Wheelock informed the Board of the 5th grade orientation on August 16-17 (Tuesday-Wednesday), 2016 from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at the middle school. **Freshman Orientation** - Mr. Wheelock stated the freshman orientation will be held on Tuesday, August 23, 2016 from 9:00 a.m. to noon at the high school.

 preferred eligible list for a period of seven years. The Superintendent is directed to notify
 Nicole Gibbons of this action.
- to appoint Nicole Gibbons to the position of teacher in the social studies tenure area for a probationary period of four years to commence September 1, 2016 and to expire September 1, 2020 (This expiration date is tentative and conditional only. Except to the extent required by the applicable provisions of Section 3012 of the Education Law, in order to be granted tenure the teacher must receive composite or overall annual professional performance review ratings pursuant to Section 3012-c and/or 3012-d of the Education Law of either effective or highly effective in at least three (3) of the four (4) preceding years, and if the teacher receives an ineffective composite or overall rating in the final year of the probationary period the teacher shall not be eligible for tenure at that time).
- to appoint Kristen Calidonna as a long-term substitute teacher (elementary school) effective September 6, 2016 through September 16, 2016 or until such time as the regular teacher returns and as a per diem substitute teacher effective September 1, 2016.

<u>Miscellaneous Topics</u> - Mr. Nelson and Mr. Shrey had concerns regarding the liability associated with students participating in the Utica College Football Camp. It isn't a school sponsored event, however, the students use school equipment for this camp. Mr. Wheelock will check with the insurance company on this issue. Mr. Nelson stated that it is important for the district to get going on a long range plan. Mr. Shrey said Dr. John King, Secretary of Education, U.S. Department of Education, desires to penalize schools if they do not achieve a 95% participation rate on New York State tests. Senator Griffo sent a letter to Dr. King expressing his disagreement with this.
