The meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m. by Mr. Nicotera.

Pledge of Allegiance - The pledge of allegiance was recited.

<u>Presentations</u> - The Bonadio Group (Review of 2016-2017 Audit) - Gregg Evans, The Bonadio Group, presented the 2016-17 audit to the Board. He distributed the draft financial packet and reviewed the information contained therein. He stated Mr. Cowen did a great job and gave the district an A+ on the audit.

<u>Public to Be Heard</u> - Mr. Nicotera asked if anyone wished to address the Board and one person did so.

Fred Orsino was present to revisit the junior varsity softball program. He said they still have the numbers for this program. Doug Jones, Athletic Director, was present to discuss reinstating the wrestling program. After some discussion, the junior varsity softball and wrestling programs will be placed on the next Board agenda for action.

<u>Students to Be Heard</u> - Mr. Nicotera asked if any students wished to address the Board and none did so. No students were present.

<u>Board of Education Sub-Committee Reports</u> - Facilities and Transportation -Mr. Wheelock stated a meeting was held on Tuesday, September 26, 2017 to discuss phase III of the capital project. A pre-bid meeting is scheduled for Thursday, October 26, 2017 with the awarding of bids on Tuesday, November 14, 2017. In order to accept the bids, a special Board meeting will have to be scheduled in November.

<u>Old Business</u> - School Tax Exemptions for Veterans - Mr. Cowen distributed information to the Board on the criteria for veterans to receive a school tax exemption should the Board decide to do this. Should the Board adopt the veteran's exemption, the reductions realized by eligible veterans would essentially be absorbed by taxpayers throughout the district.
