The meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m. by Mrs. Miller.

<u>Pledge of Allegiance</u> - The pledge of allegiance was recited.

<u>Presentation</u> - **2019-2020 Budget** – Kim Hibbard, Business Official, conducted the budget hearing. Her presentation highlighted the District's budget process, review of expenditures and revenues and the tax levy impact to tax payers. Voting on the budget, two Board seats and bus proposition to purchase two buses will take place on Tuesday, May 21, 2019 from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the elementary school in room 421.

<u>Public to Be Heard</u> - Mrs. Miller asked if anyone wished to address the Board and none did so. None present.

<u>Board Candidates Comments</u> - Todd Nelson took a moment to express his gratitude to serve three years on the school Board and looks forward to the opportunity to continue to serve for three more years.

<u>Students to Be Heard</u> - Mrs. Miller asked if anyone wished to address the Board and none did so. No students were present.

<u>Board of Education Sub-Committee Reports</u> - Facilities and Transportation – Mr. Wheelock shared that interested staff have received an orientation to the fitness center to allow the access to use this facility. The fitness center will be open for community use on a trial basis on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday in the month of June (starting June 1 through June 27).

<u>Superintendent's Report</u> - Mr. Wheelock stated, per Board request, that he will invite Adrianna Grande to the May 21<sup>st</sup> Board meeting to recognize her participation in MVCC's graduation as a senior at Sauquoit Valley. **The May 21, 2019, Board meeting** will be held in the Elementary School library.

Miscellaneous Topics - Mr. Nelson inquired if the Board would be appointing coaches for the upcoming fall and winter sports seasons. He felt the sooner we can appoint them, the sooner the coaches can conduct team-related activities during the off season. Mr. Wheelock stated coaching appointments for fall and winter coaches would be forthcoming in June, at least for those positions that have expressed interest and are recommended by the Athletic Director and Superintendent. Mrs. Miller asked how the Disney trip went for the select eighth grade students who attended in early May. Mr. Wheelock responded that this student leadership trip was excellent and well received by the students. Students engaged in various workshops designed to promote and support student leadership and they also performed a day of community service for underprivileged kids. This group is excited to bring back lessons learned and their leadership skills to share in the District. Mr. Critelli asked how the hiring process is going for our two open science positions in the high school. Mr. Wheelock said the posting for the positions expires this week and that we do have interested candidates; however, the candidate pool for such positions is not deep in numbers.
