

Spectator Attendance at Activity Practice and Events

The Head Coach of all activity teams may deny visitors including parent's access to practice to ensure a safe and orderly environment. The policy will leave the discretion regarding Open and/or closed practice to the Head Coach of the activity team. If a Head Coach chooses to operate a closed practice, all individuals that are not approved coaches and/or volunteers will be asked to leave the facility.

At Practices and Events, all visitors including parents will not be allowed to access locker-room dressing areas at any time regardless of whether students are present.

The Superintendent may seek to deny future admission to any person by delivering or mailing a notice, sent by certified mail with return receipt requested, containing:

1. The date, time, and place of a Board hearing;
2. A description of the believed infraction;
3. The proposed time period that admission to school events will be denied.
