

Employee Compensation Non-Annualized Election

The Notus School District does not offer its employees an annualized election. For the purposes of this policy, an annualized election means that an employee is allowed to choose between being paid only during the school year and being paid over a twelve (12) month period and the employee chooses to be paid over the twelve month period.
