#### HERITAGE ELEMENTARY CONSTRUCTION

Crews are working diligently on closing up the exterior of the building and have made excellent progress at Area E (Early Childhood and Kindergarten), Area C (1st and 4th grade), and Area D (2nd and 3rd grade). The steel stud framing and drywall are complete in these areas and crews have also installed window frames and glass at Area E. In areas that glass or window frames haven't been installed, the project team has provided temporary enclosures made out of either plastic or plywood. This has allowed crews to hook up temporary heat which will allow crews to begin the installation of finishing materials such as drywall mud.

#### HANDS-ON LEARNING


