Old Business:

1. Trunk or Treat- received feedback that first trunk was one where many people posed for pictures, in future will put those at the end; overall went well, voting did not work out too well- only had about 22 votes but the 4 winners were unanimous, next year want to have a central location for trunks to come get candy from dad's club to make it easier. Possibly look into including food truck next year.
2. Fall Parties- went well, parents, teachers, and kids all enjoyed it
3. Book Fair- open for trunk or treat and did about \$2000 that night; did a little over \$14,000 total; spent about \$1,600 on teacher books, about \$4,700 will go to Mrs. Koehler in the library; kids were very well behaved; from the teachers-love having the book coupons for kids who otherwise wouldn't get a book
4. School equipment- Gaga pits and soccer goals- gaga pits were delivered- contacted maintenance and they are already put together, Mrs. G set up a fake gaga pit in the gym and taught all the kids how to play; will order small panel for one of the gaga pits to make it easier to get into for the younger kids; SCSA will be giving us two soccer goals

New Business:

1. Friendsgiving Nov. 17- will be sending out sign up for meals this week, last year was successful so plan to do again
2. Dad's Club- Ben Neyer and Buddy Todd- asked question about veterans days activities during school, Trael says will be creating activities/events- silent dismissal, teachers will have choice of different activities (ex: writing service members), trying to put together lists. Used to do donuts with dads. This year doing tailgates and trying to be more involved. Had food, games, and other activities there. Will look into moving tailgate location next year. Did trunk or treat, movie on the lawn, and other various events so far this year.
3. Dine to Donate- Did well with Papa Johns (\$123.62). Next one is Thursday November 9th Zaxby's (10% of profits) and Ella's (Battle of the Groves- 20% of profits with chance at 30% if we win). As of right now, don't have one planned for December. Unfortunately, Pizza King owner sold it so it will be shutting down. Cannot do Polar Express event as it has been done in the past. Chick Fil A will be January 30th.
4. Holiday Shop- Dec 4-9. Meeting this week to work on schedules- changed how teachers sign up their class to sign up genius (teachers enjoyed this). Will do again this year. Will take a lot of parent volunteers. Previously have had older kids help younger kids shop- will discuss if we can do this again. No decision made yet.

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5. Polar Express- we are actively discussing options for how this event will work. Dad's club suggested having dine to donate via food truck. Ideas also include Santa, Polar Express train, cookies, hot chocolate, and book reading. Amanda also suggested looking into restaurants with party room. Possibly look into renting out Uno pizzeria.

6. Welcome Third Grade Teachers- each teacher introduced themselves. Collected cans for service center- were so happy to receive them. Appreciate all the things PTO does for the school and kids. 3rd grade is big testing year. 38.4% free and reduced lunch- direct correlation to school performance. Working on three-digit multiplication, writing- being able to communicate through your writing. Will be doing holiday book reports. Will try to do a book challenge- read books you don't normally read, read 15 books total.
