IX. RESOLUTION #2023-92: It is recommended by the treasurer to approve the following:

A. To proceed with the submission of a renewal tax levy.

WHEREAS, the electors of the Campbell City School District approved a renewal tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation at the May 7, 2019 election in order to raise the amount of \$989,711 each year for a period of five (5) years, for the purpose of providing for emergency operating requirements of the School District; and

WHEREAS, the authority to levy that tax expires with the levy to be made on the 2024 tax list and duplicate for collection in calendar year 2025, and, in order to provide for the collection of tax revenues for that purpose without interruption, this Board of Education finds it necessary to renew the existing levy of \$989,711 per year for ten (10) years.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Campbell City School District (herein the "School District").

SECTION 1. That the amount of revenue which may be raised in this School District by all tax levies which this School District is authorized to impose, when combined with all revenues to be received from the State of Ohio and the Federal Government, will be insufficient to provide for the emergency requirements of the School District.

SECTION 2. That pursuant to the provisions of Section 5705.194 of the Ohio Revised Code, it is necessary that a renewal tax be levied in excess of the ten-mill limitation upon the entire territory of the School District for the benefit of this School District, for the purpose of providing for the emergency requirements of the School District, in the amount of \$989,711 each year for a ten (10) year period.

SECTION 3. That the question of the adoption of said renewal tax levy shall be submitted to the electors of the entire territory of the School District at the election to be held on March 19, 2024. If approved by the electors, said tax levy shall first be placed upon the 2025 tax list and duplicate, for first collection in calendar year 2026.

SECTION 4. That the Treasurer of this Board of Education be and is hereby directed to certify forthwith a copy of this resolution to the County Auditor at least one-hundred days prior to said election as required by law so that said County Auditor may calculate the number of mills for each one dollar of taxable value which will be required to generate the amount required to produce the annual amount set forth in Section 2 hereof; and the levy's rate expressed in dollars, rounded to the nearest dollar, for each one hundred thousand dollars of appraised value required to produce the annual amount set forth in Section 2 hereof, in accordance with Section 5705.195 of the Ohio Revised Code and so that the County Auditor may certify to this Board of Education the total current tax valuation of the district, in accordance with Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board of Education concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board of Education, and that all deliberations of this Board of Education, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the rules of this Board of Education adopted in accordance therewith.
