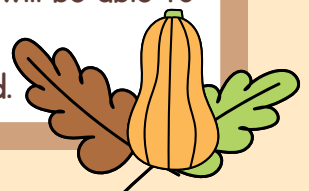


PARENT PORTAL

Remember to create your parent portal account through PowerSchool. You can create this account by clicking [here](#). There are detailed instructions at the bottom of the page. You will need your child(ren)'s student ID number to create the account and you can get this by contacting the homeroom teacher or Deb at the front office.

The parent portal is where you will be able to access report cards, see current grades, and verify attendance. Finally, you can access directory information for other students in your child's grade. The district no longer allows schools or teachers to print out directory information for parents, so if you need contact information this is where you will be able to find it.

Please sign up as soon as possible as report cards will not be mailed.



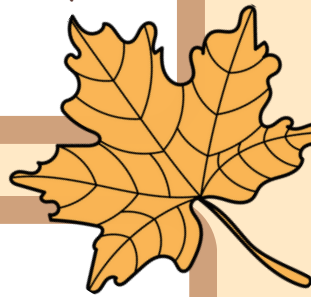
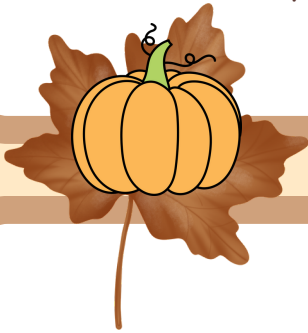


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COUNSELING CORNER

Our School Counselor Mrs. Schleifman is moving into her second unit of Second Step with students. Students have already learned skills for learning: Focus Attention, Listen, Use Self-Talk, and Be Assertive. The second unit is about empathy. Lessons will cover identifying feelings, understanding perspectives, showing compassion, and making friends. Students will be challenged to recognize how others are feeling based on observing facial expressions, body language, and situations. Students will also practice how compassion is empathy in action. We must first have empathy to then be compassionate with our actions and words. Ask your student to sing you a song from Second Step!

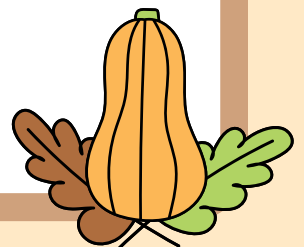


VOLUNTEERS
