

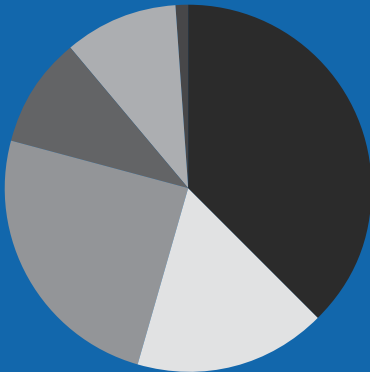
Our Story

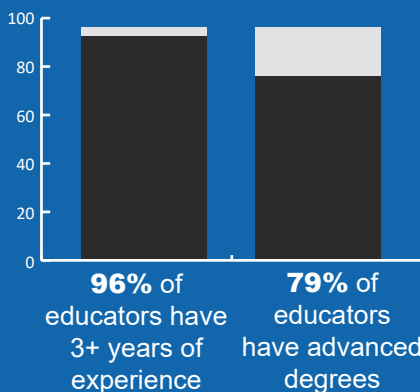
