CARPOOL SAFETY

Please do not make U-Turns on 2000 East.






 - COSTUMES SHOULD NOT HINDER YOUR ABILITY TO PARTICIPATE IN CLASSES
 - COSTUMES SHOULD INCLUDE SHOES
 - COSTUMES AND DRESSING UP IS OPTIONAL
