- You can enroll in ORAL INTERPRETATION which is performing arts credit. (You need a visual/performing art to graduate!)

- Competitors are not graded on their competition scores, just preparation and participation.
- Students unable to take the class are encouraged to join afterschool Speech and Debate in D8. These sessions are personalized to your needs to help you prepare for tournament events.
