



Moving Physical Education Ahead...

Phase I: Raise Awareness (Fall 2020-Fall 2021)

- o Provide training on the new NYS standards;
- o Promote awareness of the rollout timeline;
- o Initiate statewide collaboration with BOCES, school districts, professional organizations, and higher education.

Phase II: Build Capacity (Fall 2021-Fall 2022)

- o Provide guidance for local programs and curriculum development
- o Provide additional standards resources for schools
- o Continue statewide training.

Phase III: Full Implementation (Fall 2023)

o First full year of new NYS standards implemented in the classroom.


To fulfill this purpose, we must:
