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INSTRUCTION

Curriculum Design

- I. The curricula of our schools shall be in harmony with the Board's adopted goals and legal requirements.
- II. Curriculum development by the certificated staff shall be guided by such factors as the following:
 - A. Actual studies and information concerning the needs of students in this District.
 - B. The range of abilities, aptitudes and interests of our students.
 - C. Aspirations of residents of the District for our students.
 - D. The mobility of our population, making it necessary to provide an education for our students useful anywhere in the world.
 - E. Avoidance of discrimination (Ed. Code 40).
- III. The Board desires that unnecessary duplication of work among the various school levels be eliminated, and that courses of study and syllabi be coordinated effectively.
- IV. The Board favors providing opportunities for faculty to consult and help in curriculum development through such devices as workshops, study groups and assistance from outside consultants.
- V. The Board reserves the responsibility for establishing curricula for the District. Teachers shall teach within the approved curricula.
