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INSTRUCTION

Standards for Student Achievement

An environment which meets district standards and promotes academic progress for students would include the expectations by staff that:

- A. All students are capable of stretching to higher levels of achievement regardless of level.
- B. Teacher behaviors that promote equal opportunity in the classroom for all students will be in evidence in the classrooms throughout the school.
- C. Students are held accountable for completing assigned work.
- D. Daily assigned work and classroom tests show a mastery level of 85 percent or better.
- E. Remediation plans will be developed for those who do not master basic skills.
- F. Homework will be given to support mastery of concepts/skills learned in class.
- G. Students will obtain the required standards on district grade level proficiency tests.
- H. Scores on the state testing program shall be in the upper 25 percent of schools like their own on the state assessments.
- I. Each grade level will score in the upper quartile.
- J. Students will show evidence of organization and neatness on daily assignments.
- K. Students will come to school/class on time, prepared to work.
- L. Parents are informed of standards for student achievement and then support solicited.
