

For Previous ZoomQ Users:

We will once again be using ZoomQ for our car rider dismissal system. Old passwords have expired, so you will need to set up a new password before Thursday's dismissal.

- 1) Go to https://app.zoomq.com.
- 2) Click on **FORGOT PASSWORD.**
- 3) Provide your **email address**.
- 4) Check your email for the link to set up password.
- 5) Create a password.
- 6) Go back to https://app.zoomq.com.
- 7) Use your email address and password to log into your ZoomQ account.
