



# TCBOE Wi-Fi Hotspot Policy

Use of a district provided hotspot is subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this policy. By checking out a hotspot, parties have agreed to the following:

- Hotspots can be checked out to students (based on availability) by contacting the student's base school.
- The student is responsible for the return of the hotspot and the power adapter. Failure to return will result in a replacement charge of \$40.
- Hotspots run on the AT&T network and the speed and availability of the Wi-Fi connection will be dependent on the service area of AT&T towers. Service connection is not guaranteed in all areas.
- Use of this equipment is intended for educational purposes outside of the school setting with a **district provided device**.
- District provided devices are filtered and monitored by Lightspeed Relay and Gaggle.
- The District prohibits unethical use of the Internet, email, and other media. Violation of this policy may result in the loss of equipment and privileges, and disciplinary action by the campus.
- Parents/guardians are responsible for monitoring what their children access while using the hotspots.
- There is no Internet filtering software on the hotspots. Therefore, any personal device that is connected to the hotspot is subject to AT&T's Acceptable Use Policy, Privacy Policy and Terms of Use.
- TCBOE assumes no liability for any material accessed on the hotspot.
- TCBOE is not responsible for any files, data, or personal information accessed, transmitted, lost or damaged while accessing the Internet via the hotspot.
