NEED HELP MEETING YOUR HEATING NEEDS?

The Crisis Assistance Program is designed to help households overcome energy emergencies which cannot be met by other resources. An energy emergency is determined when a household has no heat or is in imminent danger of being without heat. Crisis Assistance helps with one or more of the following: payment of primary heat source utility bills beginning 1/2/24; payment of security deposits for primary heat utility; purchase of primary home heating fuel when the fuel supply is low; repair of inoperable or unsafe heating equipment; replacement of heating equipment for homeowners only when repair isn't possible; and provision of supplemental heating equipment maintenance.

The open application period runs through March 15 for heating equipment repair/purchase/maintenance and a one-time only heat security deposit. The first business day in January through March 15 is the time frame for purchase of home heating fuel and payment of a heat utility bill.

Reston at the Lake Anne Office Building, 11484 Washington Plaza West.

CHECK YOUR TAXES ONLINE

The IRS is promoting its online accounts for individuals, according to The Kiplinger Tax Letter. The accounts can be used to see if you owe back taxes; make a payment online; review payment plan options, if needed; access tax records and transcripts; validate bank account information; and get digital copies of IRS notices. Additional features include live chat, secure messaging, and a virtual assistant. For a full rundown of how to open an account, go to www.irs.gov/pub/irs-pdf/p5507/ pdf.



FYI: THE FOUR PHASES OF OLD AGE

About 25% of individuals older than 65 will die without having any significant limitations on their ability to care for themselves. Another 20% will experience significant difficulty with multiple activities of daily living. The rest will fall somewhere in the middle, needing support with some daily activities but maintaining independence in other areas. MIT's Age Lab divides retirement into four distinct phases, each of which introduces new needs and potential service providers: I hope you'll find them interesting

Managing ambiguity. In the first phase, you may have retired from your career but continue to work part-time, do consulting, or volunteer activity. You may travel and try out new fitness or cultural

activities. Your employer can assist in retirement finances, or you may hire a financial adviser to assess your financial security and plan. If you want to start a part-time gig, a career coach could be useful. Consider engaging with your church or a cause you care about to add purpose to your life.

Managing big decisions.

At some point, a change in circumstances prompts the need for rethinking where you live or another aspect of your lifestyle. An injury or illness, whether it's yourself or your spouse, might cause you to think about downsizing. You might remodel your home or relocate. You'll be relying on real estate agents, contractors and apartment building managers. At the high end, some apartments will sell you a turnkey package of housekeeping and services to extend your ability to live independently.

Managing complexity. When chronic health conditions begin to catch up with you, new health care providers come into your life. You might visit a cardiologist or physical therapist regularly. The lawn care and housekeeping workers who used to be a convenience now become a crucial part of your entourage.

Living solo. The final stage, for most people, will be living alone for the better part of a decade, after the death of a spouse. This period is especially true for women, who tend to outlive their male partners. That's where the services really come into play, for everything from taking out the trash to home care. 
