\$34M Deficit Given Scope of Work Required

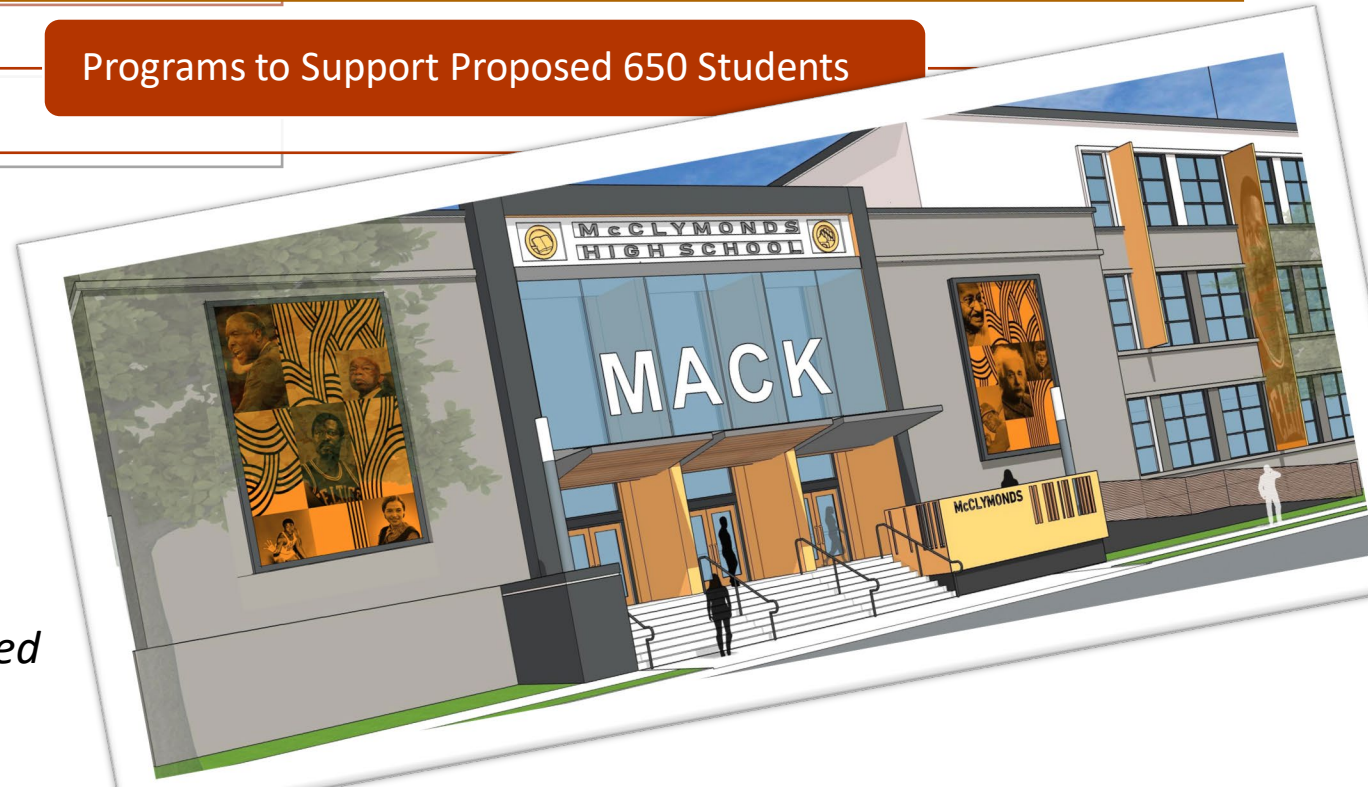
Design-Build (80% Schematic Design)

Adult School (Removal from School Grounds)

Relocation is the intention. However, the HS Network Superintendent has not confirmed this can be done at this time.

Community Input

Community has input on various concept designs, colors, materials, and scope. However, when health, safety, and code are in question, all community input will be secondary as these items will be priority.

Consistency of Meeting Content (Facilities vs Community Mtgs)

Project Managers complete a fact sheet in preparation for the Facilities Meeting and Leadership relays this information. Moving forward, we will check for consistency prior to submitting to Leadership for presentation.

Factors Determining 650 Proposed Student Body

The 650 proposed student body was developed by the District to support the “Quality Community School Model” that indicates a specific number of base faculty and specialized departmental staff will support proposed growing enrollment. The goal for 2026-27 was set at 650 if the enrollment increased by ~15.1% every year from 2022 (368)

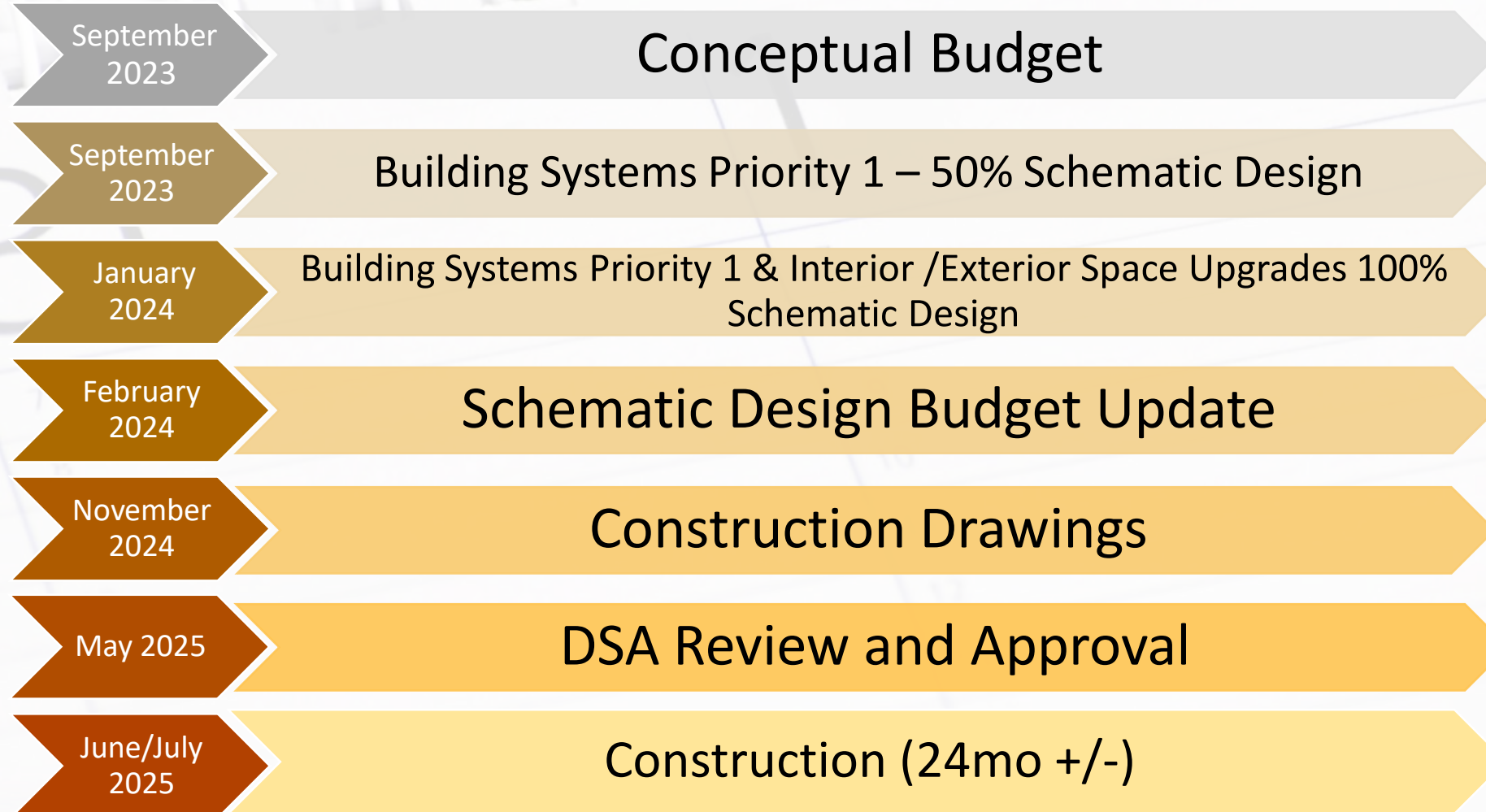

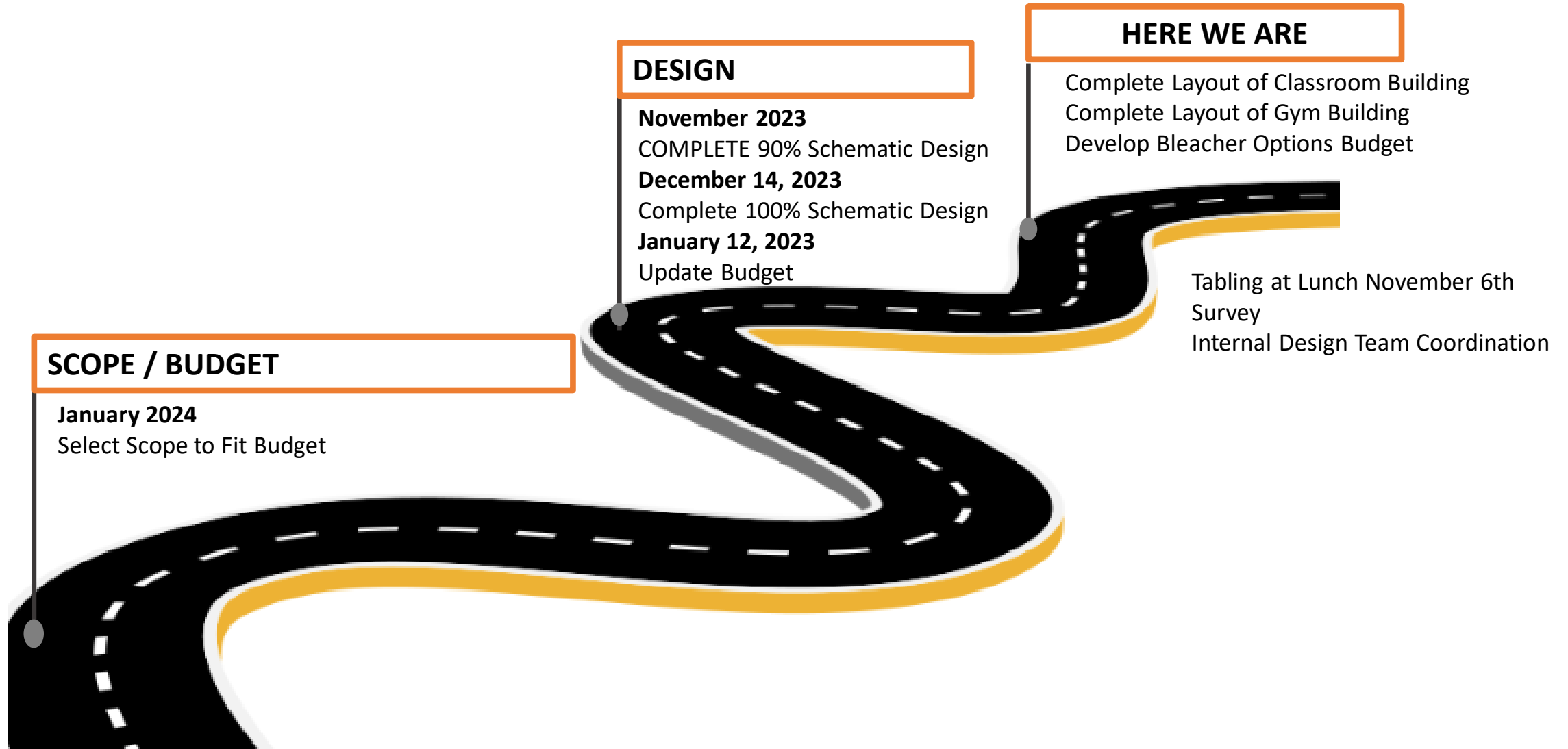

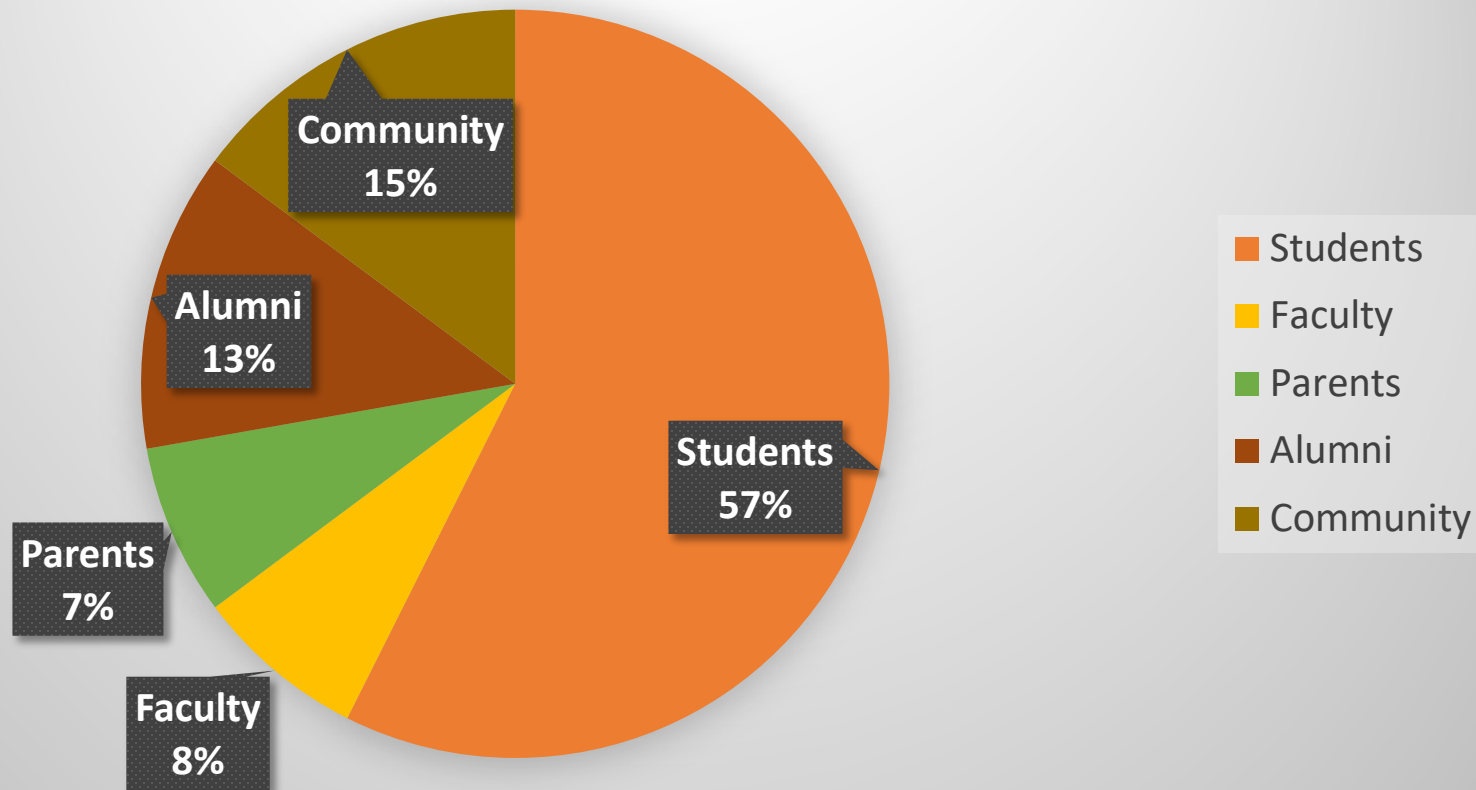

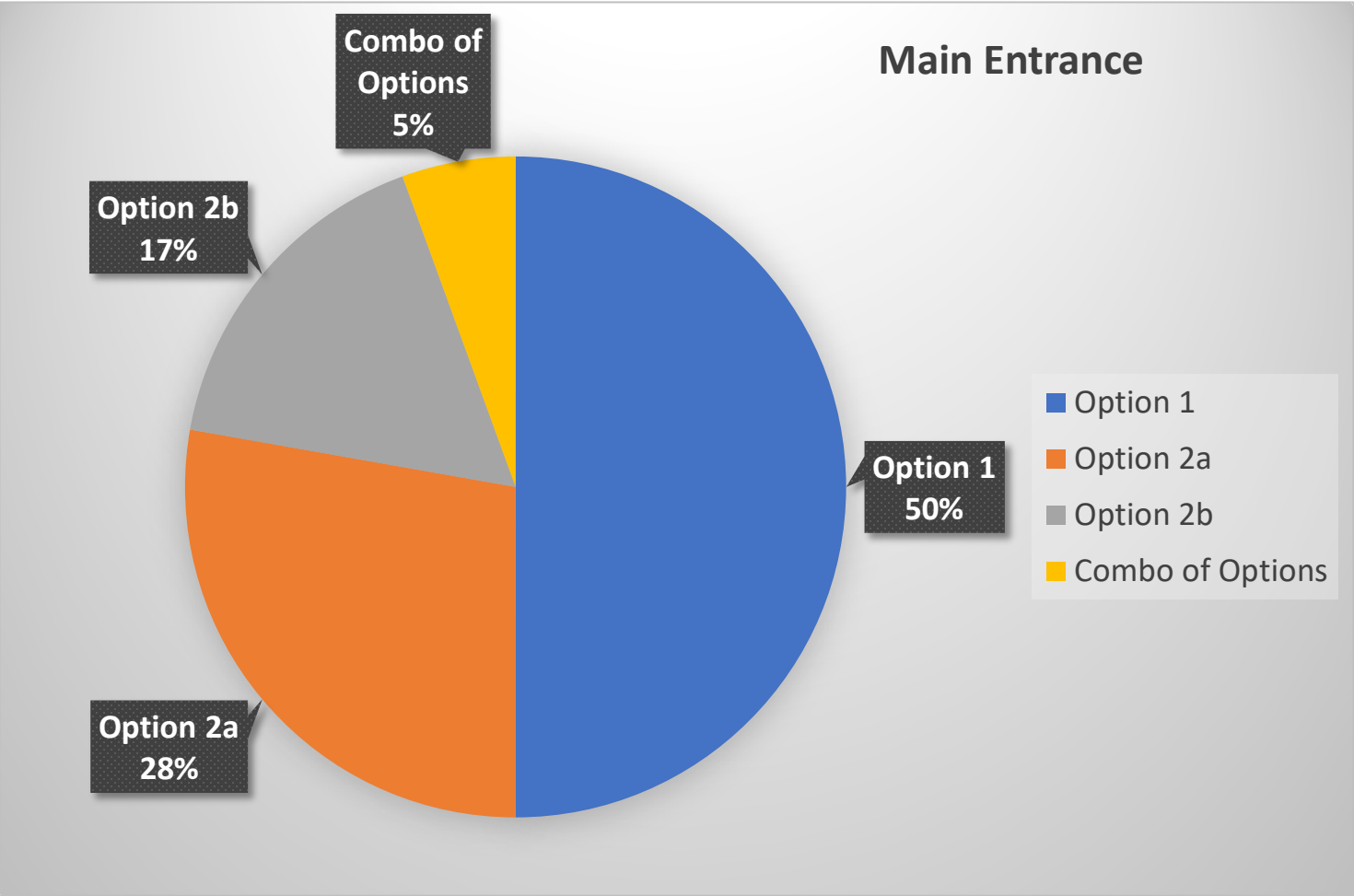

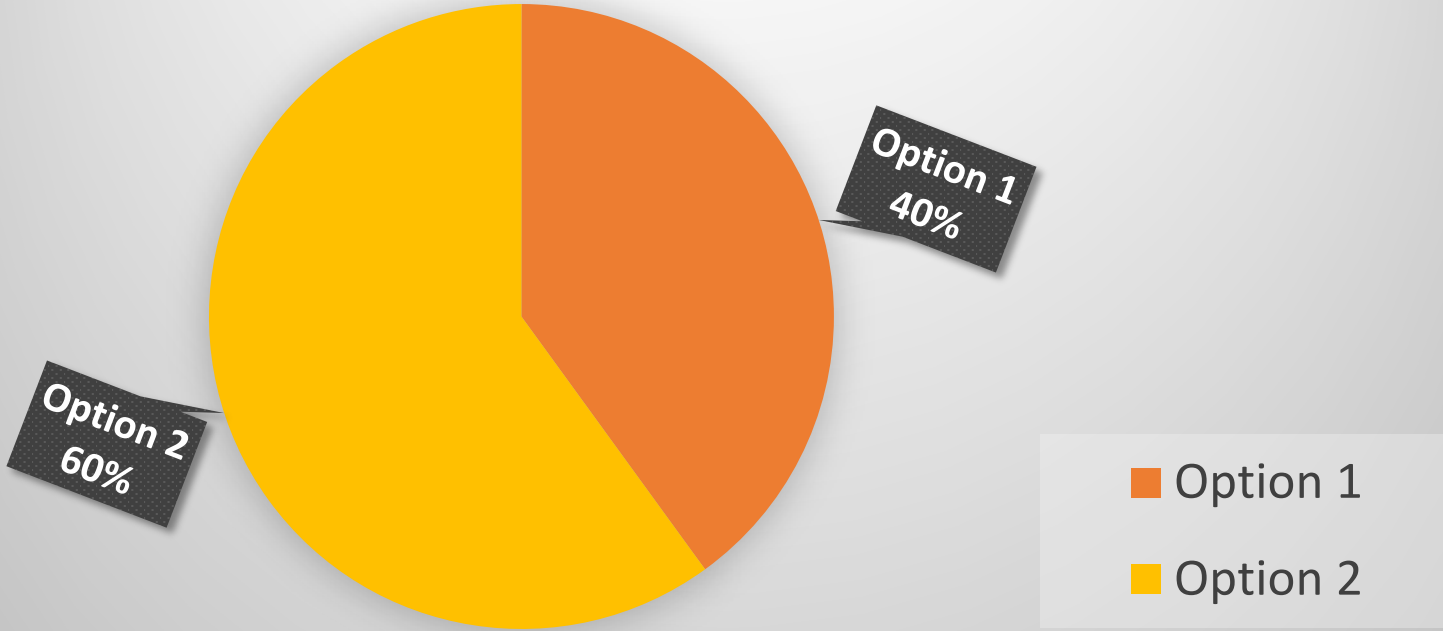
Main School Entrance

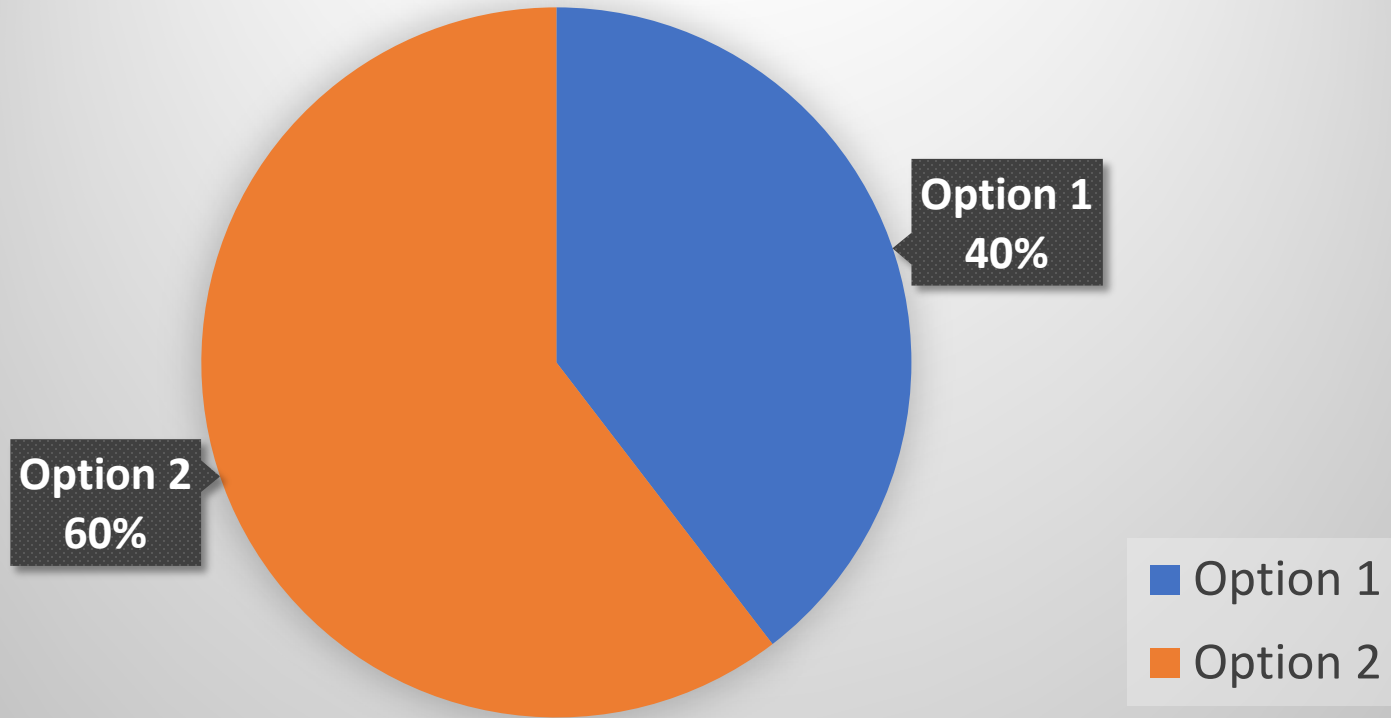

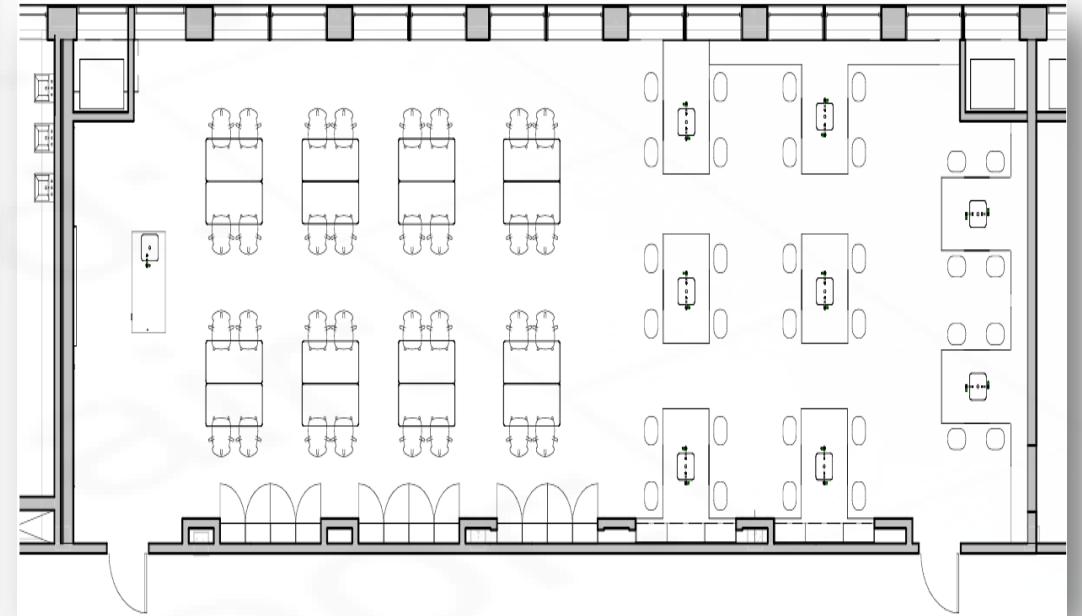

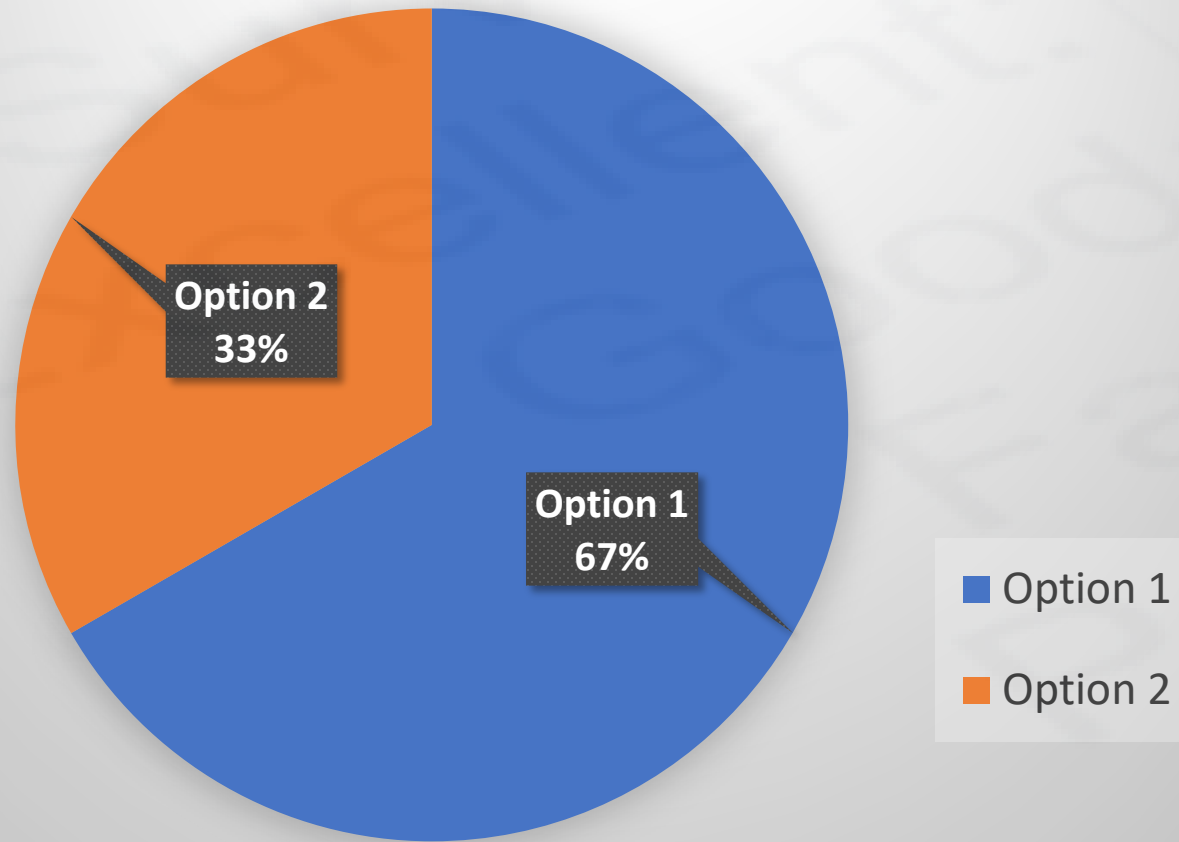

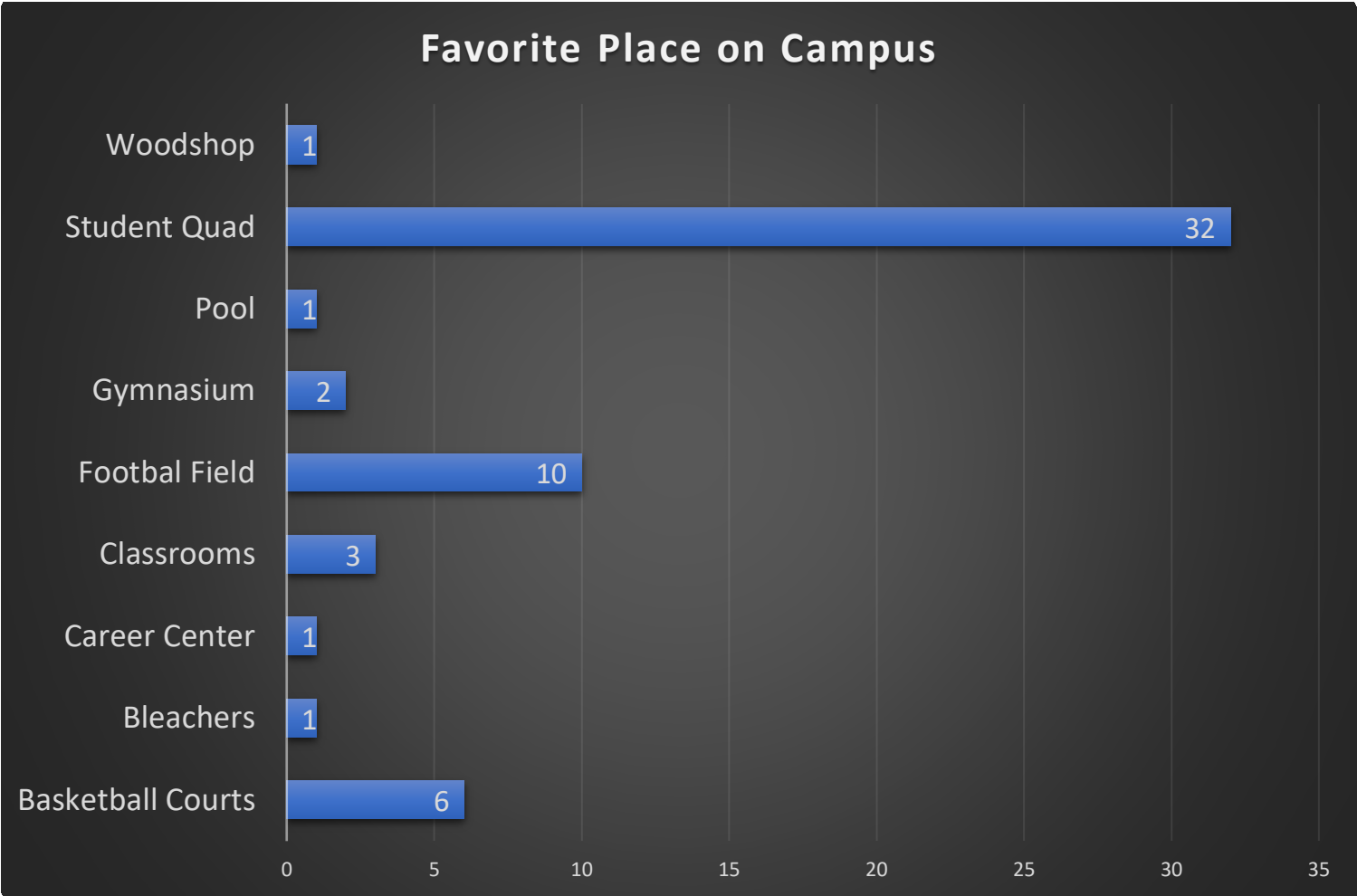

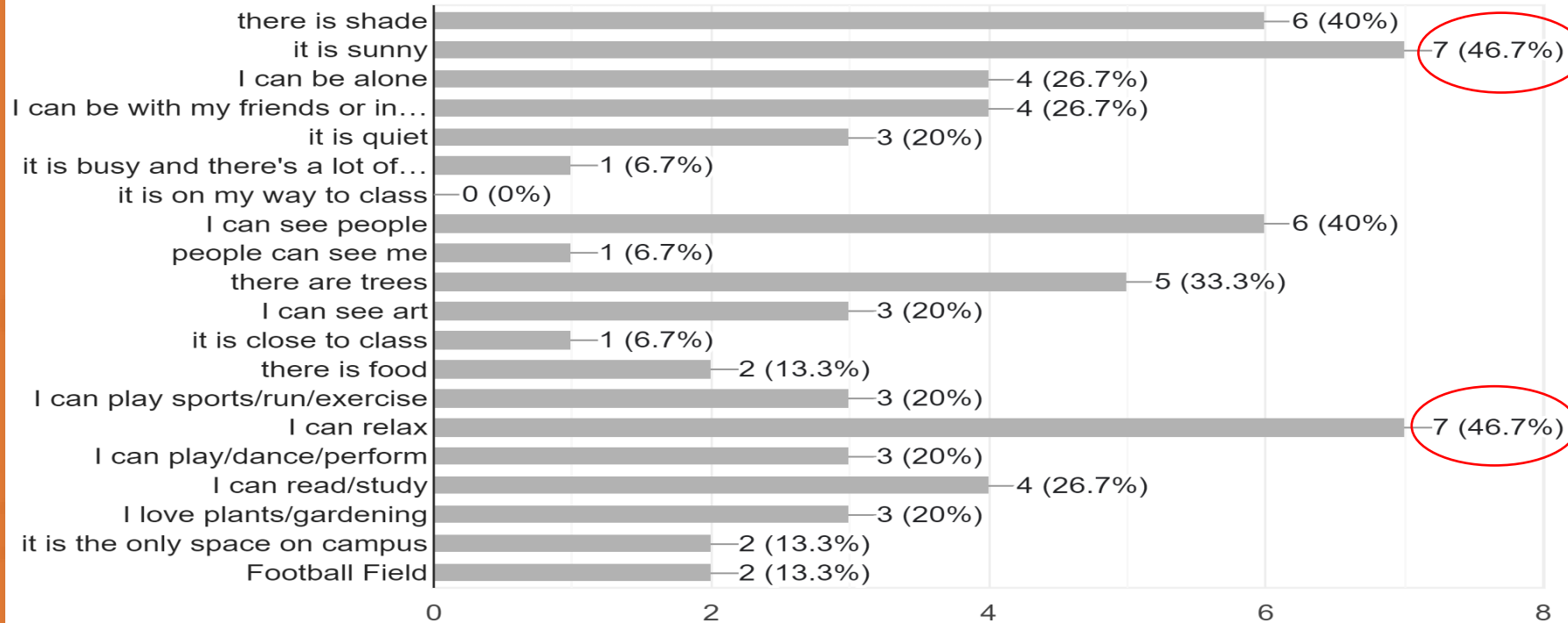

Main Entry Points on Campus



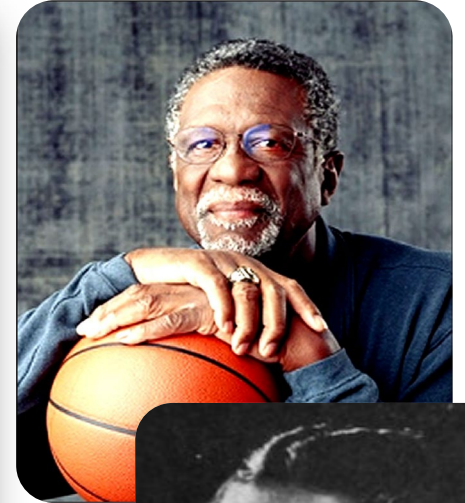
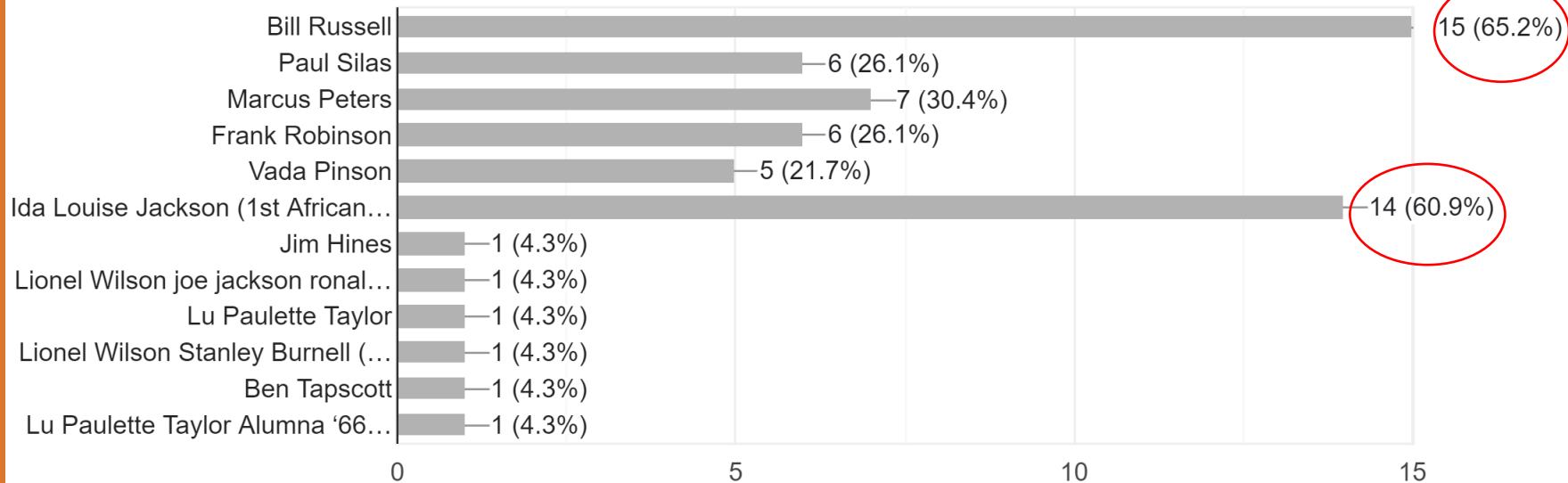
