

CE Tennis

All our lessons use the "progressive Tennis" system of modified courts and balls designed for the age and/or skill level of the players. Scale appropriate learning is used by many other sports (e.g. T-Ball, Mini-soccer, etc.) Tennis is learned faster and easier through this system.

Red Level 1

Age 5-7

This program introduces the foundational skills of tennis with an oversized low-compression ball on a smaller court. Players learn basic rally, serve and net play skills along with activities that build tennis specific coordination.

Red Level 2

Age 5-7

This follow- up to Red Level 1 further refines the rally, serve, and net play skills. Players learn to compete on a Red Court with oversized low-compression balls.

Orange Level 1

Age 8-10

Orange tennis is played on a 3/4 size court with a low-compression ball. Players learn how to serve, rally, score and play at the net.

Orange Level 2

Age 8-10

This follow-up to Orange Level 1 is on a 3/4 size court with a low– compression ball. Players learn to maintain a rally when receiving more challenging shots, serve with improved placement, approach the net and place volleys.

Green Level 1

Age 11-14


