BOARD RESIDENCE IN CORPORATION AFTER ELECTION

The Board interprets Indiana law to state that if a member of the Board of School Trustees ceases to be a resident in the district from which that member resided when elected or appointed to the Board, but the member still resides within the Lafayette School Corporation, then so long as the member continues to be a resident of the Lafayette School Corporation, there will not be a vacancy for that member's district during the balance of the term.
