## ADMINISTRATION OF POLICY ABSENCE

In cases where action must be taken within the school system and where the board has provided no guidelines for action, the superintendent of schools is delegated the authority to act and the responsibility to report significant actions to the board.

As agents of the board, the administration is granted the authority to act on behalf of the board in carrying out the powers granted to the board in the School Powers Act. Specifically, the administration is empowered to carry out such actions which may be reasonable from an education, business, or personnel standpoint. In the event of any regulatory body requires that additional documentation of a specific policy be further reduces to writing, then this policy shall be amended.
