Physical Examination for Administrators

The board recommends each administrator undergo an annual physical examination. The board authorizes a basic physical examination. The exam will include those tests recommended by the area physicians. Their recommendations will be based on preventative health care guidelines including those from the American College of Physicians, the U. S. Preventative Services Task Force, and the American Cancer Society. If an administrator is under medical care, he/she may elect to provide documentation that a physical examination has been conducted by his/her physician in lieu of the physical examination to be provided by the corporation. In such case, the corporation will pay an amount not to exceed the standard usual and customary charge allowed by the corporation's insurance carrier. The administrator may have the option of declining to undergo certain portions of the physical examination if he/she feels as though a particular aspect of the examination would be physically uncomfortable, or present a risk to the individual's health. If an examination is completed, the board will pay for the examination.
