

LIMITED OPEN FORUM

Whereas, the United States Congress has enacted the Equal Access Act requiring school boards to permit students to conduct non-curriculum related meetings during non-instructional time on school premises if the school board permits student groups to so meet, and

Whereas, the school board hereby expresses its willingness to abide by the act and enacts this policy to do so, the board authorizes the superintendent of schools to prepare administrative regulations to create a limited open forum in accordance with related board policy and existing employee contracts.

Curriculum related student groups shall not be limited to but shall include any group or activity which the school system supports financially.

This policy is effective during the school year.
