Use of Lafayette School Corporation Facilities during Local Disasters

The Lafayette School Corporation Board of School Trustees supports the concept of making school buildings available to provide shelter for the General Public in times of a local disaster. It is understood that buildings will be opened for drills and/or practice alerts. It is also understood that local armories and Armed Forces Reserve Centers will be used prior to any request for Lafayette School Corporation facilities.

Requests for use of facilities should come from the Mayor, Emergency Management Authority, or Red Cross Disaster Chairman.

The Superintendent is responsible for developing procedures to implement this policy.
