

Use of an Automatic External Defibrillator

Any school in the Lafayette School Corporation choosing to make an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) available in their building must:

1. receive approval from the district's Emergency Management Coordinator and the Coordinator of School Nurses under the direction of the district's licensed physician;
2. ensure that the AED is maintained and tested according to the manufacturer's operational guidelines;
3. include the designated location in the school's emergency crisis plan.

During an emergency where the AED is being used, the AED user must notify the ambulance service provider and, after completing AED use, complete an incident report to be returned to the building principal and school nurse.

All persons utilizing an AED are immune from liability while rendering emergency first aid as stated in I.C. 34-30-12.
