

POLICY FOR ASSIGNMENT OF STUDENTS TO SCHOOLS

In order to establish consistency in the enrollment patterns of individual schools, to enhance the orderly management of a school, and to ensure fair and consistent assignments of students to schools, the Board believes that a student's school assignment should be clear, unambiguous, and free from arbitrary or capricious judgments.

The Board delegates to the Superintendent the responsibility for establishing procedures by which students are normally assigned to schools as well as procedures to cover special circumstances where transfer to a different school will be permitted.
