

SUB POLICY – ADVANCED ACADEMIC PROGRAM

EL-10.5

The Superintendent shall not operate without developing and adopting culturally responsive advanced preparatory program(s) that enable all students to achieve the Board's Ends policies.

Accordingly, the Superintendent will not:

1. Operate without establishing standards for advanced program enrollment across grade levels.
2. Operate without communicating enrollment standards to parents, school staff, and the public in a manner that facilitates timely enrollment.
3. Operate without ensuring advanced programs and course work are available for all students.
4. Operate without establishing procedures to identify when a student has achieved the recommended standards for success in advanced academic programs including a criteria that does not preclude the self-selection process in the high school years.
