

POLICY - HOME/HOSPITAL INSTRUCTION

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Upon request from a parent or an adult student, home/hospital instruction shall be provided to students who are unable to attend school for an estimated period of four (4) weeks or more because of a disability or illness. A written statement from a qualified medical practitioner verifying that the student will not be able to attend school for an estimated period of four (4) weeks or more shall accompany the request. The duration of home/hospital services shall reflect Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction limitations. The District shall not pay for any costs incurred in securing the medical verification.
