

POLICY - STUDENT ENROLLMENT 21 YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER 3113

Residents of the District age five (5) through twenty (20) are entitled to attend grades Kindergarten through twelve conducted by the District. Persons twenty-one (21) years of age and older will in most circumstances find their educational needs to be better served by other agencies.

Students twenty-one (21) years of age or older will be considered for enrollment in District schools only when it is determined by the Board that the applicant's enrollment in programs available through adult educational agencies will result in an undue hardship for the student.

Any resident or nonresident student twenty-one (21) years of age or older desiring to enroll District schools shall make application at the office of the Superintendent. Approval of any and each such enrollment application shall be granted only by the Board.

Students twenty-one (21) years of age or older may be admitted only pursuant to an agreement between the student and the Board. Such agreement shall set forth:

1. The name, age and grade level of attendance of the student;
2. The duration of the agreement;
3. A finding that the student will be best accommodated in the programs of the District; and
4. Such other terms and conditions as are deemed advisable and as are consistent with the policies of the District, state statute and state rules and regulations.
