POLICY - FOREIGN EXCHANGE STUDENTS

The District recognizes the benefits derived from the placement of foreign exchange students from throughout the world in our high school programs. These benefits accrue to the foreign exchange student, to the community host family and to the school population as a whole. The Superintendent or the Superintendent's designee will establish procedures to ensure that the acceptance and placement of foreign exchange students in our high schools will be a beneficial and noteworthy experience for all involved. The District, school involved and its employees shall not divert significant time, effort or resources on behalf of approved sponsoring organizations or foreign exchange students if such is thought to be in conflict with or at the expense of the regular school program.
