

SUPPLEMENTAL MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

BY AND BETWEEN THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS AND BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CHAPPAQUA CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT, hereinafter referred to as "The District" and **THE CHAPPAQUA CONGRESS OF TEACHERS** hereinafter referred to as "The CCT";

WHEREBY, the District and the CCT agree to modify the provisions of their existing Collectively Negotiated Agreement (CNA) covering the term commencing July 1, 2015 and terminating on June 30, 2018 as follows:

THEREFORE, it is agreed to modify Article 11 (P).

When the district determines a need to cover a class or classes for a teacher who is unexpectedly absent for at least two (2) full cycles, for a period of time in one of the secondary schools (5-12 grades), the district may solicit volunteers from among those appropriately certified teachers on staff to teach an additional class, on an emergency basis, that would push a teacher's total minutes beyond the contractual teaching time limits per day and/or per six-day cycle. This would be for teachers teaching at least four (4) days per cycle. This assignment may be ended at any time by the district. The teacher will be compensated at the hourly rate of 1/200 of his or her contract salary divided by six hours, with the additional class considered a single hour. The teacher will be compensated for one hour for each day when school is in session and additional days to complete grading may be approved by the building principal.
