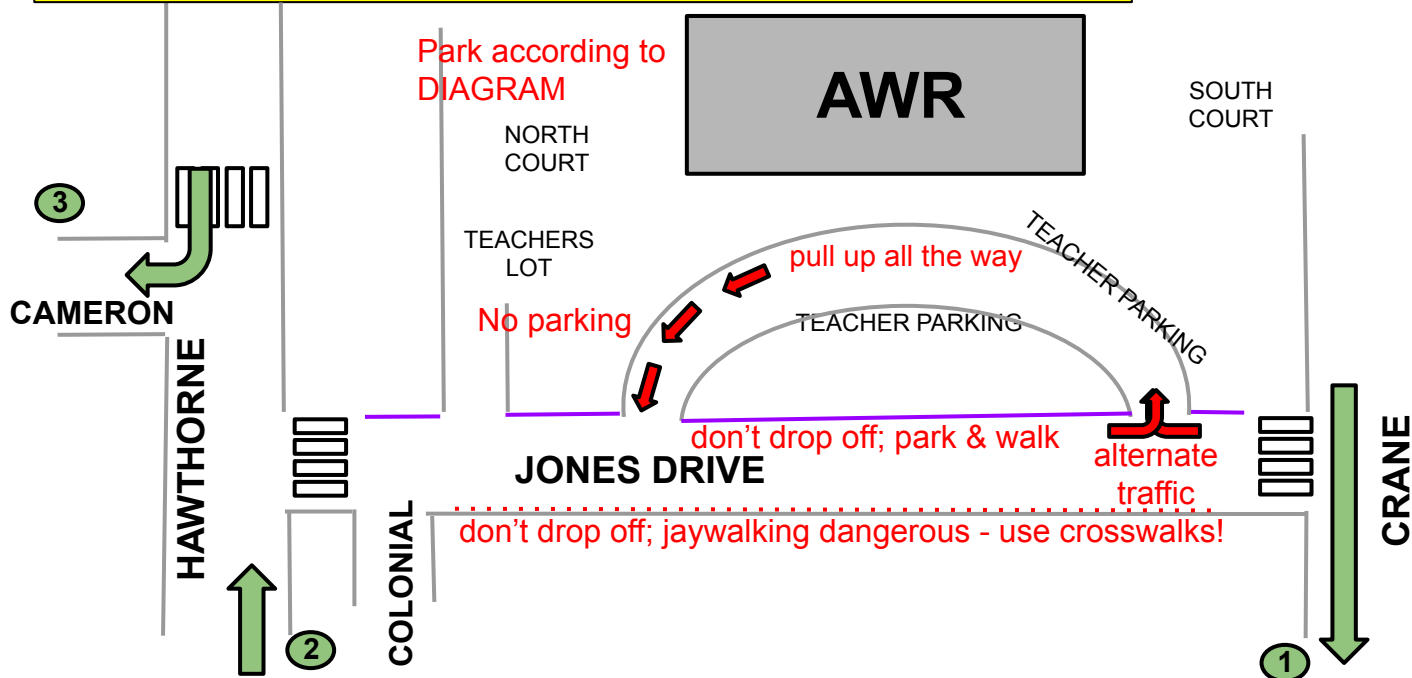


AWR Dropoff and Pickup

must be shared with ALL caregivers transporting your children



MORNING DROP OFF - Front Circle (off of Jones Drive)

- Opens at 8:15 am.
- Adhere to the “every other car rule” when entering from Jones Drive and Crane Circle.
- There is NO PARKING in the front circle.
- PULL UP as far forward in the front circle as you can (to the “Drop Off Starts Here” sign) or to the car in front of you to allow for more cars to drop off simultaneously (at least 10 cars!).
- DO NOT STOP HALFWAY near the front door. This incurs unnecessary delays for the cars behind you.
- Children MUST EXIT ON THE RIGHT, onto the sidewalk. Please make it easy by moving younger children’s car seats behind the driver.
- If children cannot reliably exit the car on their own, do not use drop off. [Park & Walk](http://awrpta.org) (see awrpta.org).
- DO NOT PASS cars on the left in the circle. Wait until the cars in front of you are moving.
- Left turns when exiting onto Jones Drive is permissible, but consider turning right to ease congestion.
- If on Jones Drive, let cars in that want to exit the circle to keep traffic moving (if they can’t exit, you can’t enter).

AFTERNOON PICK UP

- **THE FRONT CIRCLE IS CLOSED from 2:30 pm - 3:30 pm (BUSES ONLY)**
- Additional parking is on Jones, Crane, Colonial, Hawthorne, Cameron, Commerce & Spring
- THE NORTH COURT AREA IS OPEN for pick up beginning at 2:50 pm. Cars MUST follow the parking diagram (See awrpta.org). BACK cars into spots along the perimeter; NO PARKING in the middle of the lot; EXIT if no available spots.
- ABSOLUTELY NO PARKING in the teachers parking lot!

ALL DAY

- Do not abandon vehicles, even for a minute, in the front circle; it is a FIRE ZONE.
- If you park on Colonial Way, use the crosswalks/crossing guards at either end of Jones Drive.
- Turn the Key; Be Idle Free - by law, standing vehicles can only idle 3 minutes.
- **FINABLE OFFENSES: Double Parking, Jaywalking, Cell Phone usage while driving. IT’S THE LAW!**
