During class, students continue to learn and practice new library skills and technology skills.


Young 5, Kindergarten, and Frist Grade students are learning about the parts of a book, how to navigate a website, and practice mouse skills.


If you answered “Yes” to either of these questions, you are in luck! We still have copies available of this amazing cookbook!



1st Saturday of every month



Food Gatherers truck arrives @ 9 AM
