

#### **Historical Look At Funding**



(a) 09/10 reflects Section 11d funding reduction of \$154 per pupil

(b) 10/11 reflects Section 11d funding reduction of \$170 per pupil

(c) 11/12 \$170 reduction noted for 10/11 was statutory enacted in 11/12, along with an additional \$300 per pupil rollback of foundation allowance
