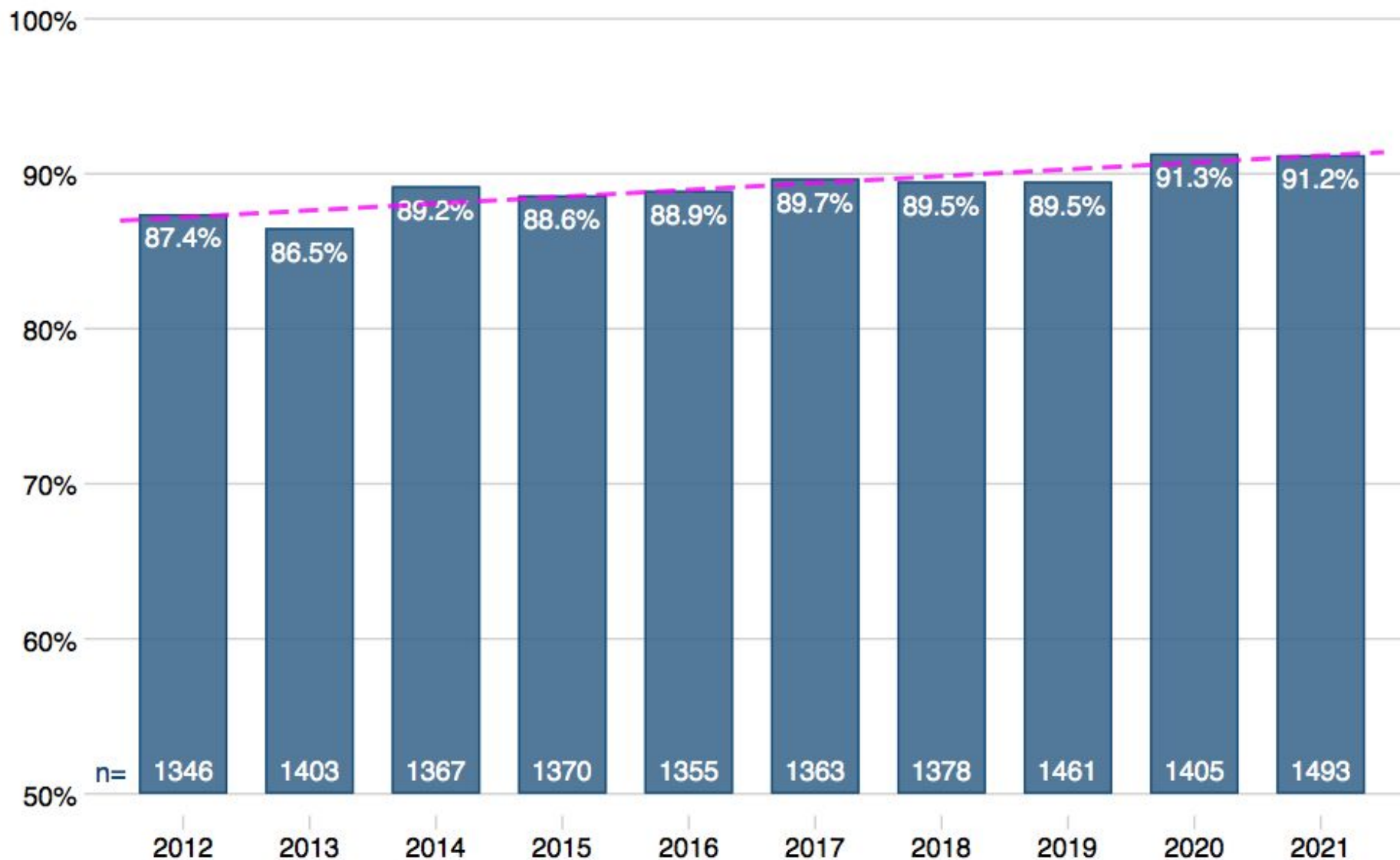

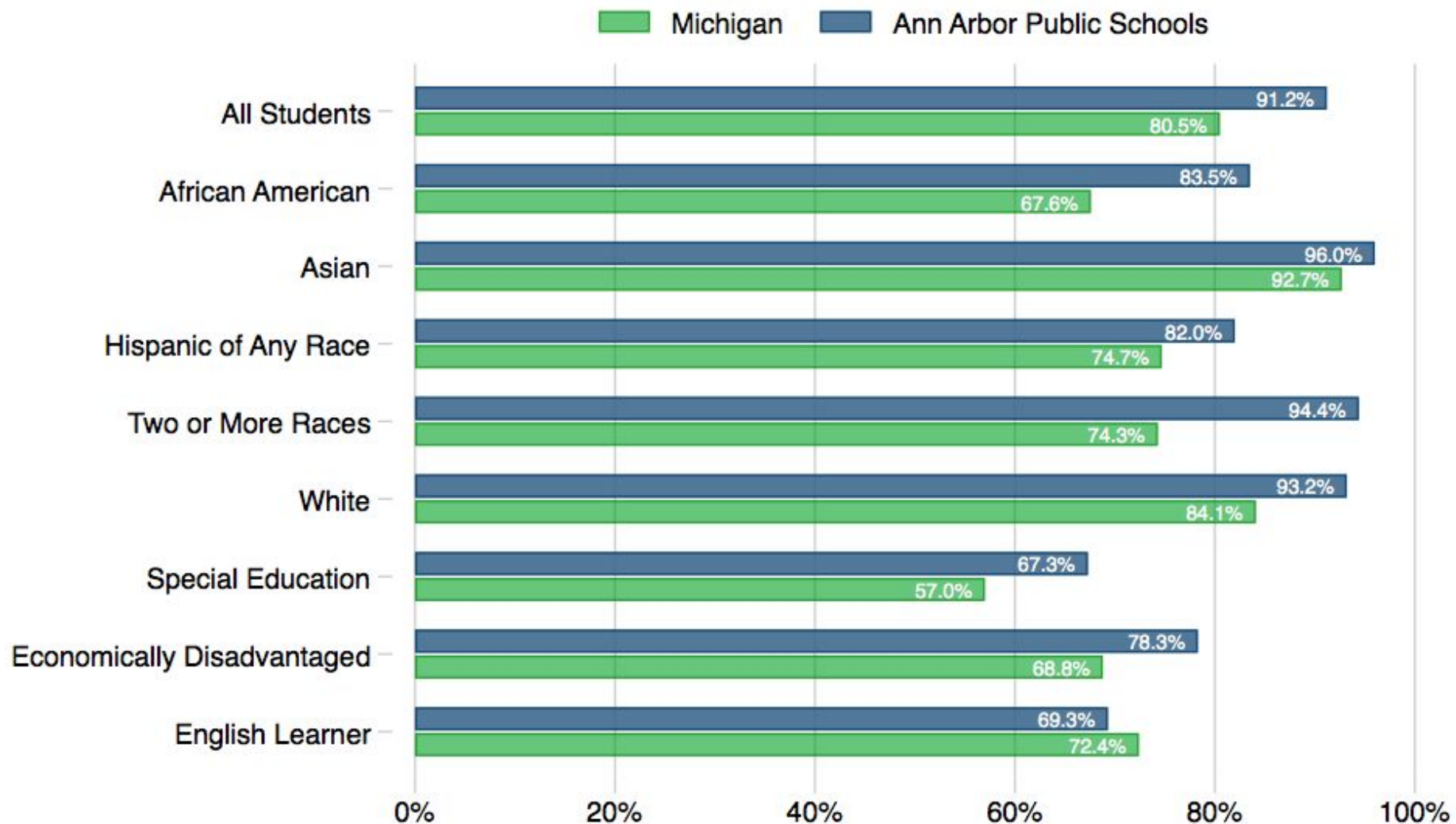

## AAPS 4-Year Graduation Rate Over Time



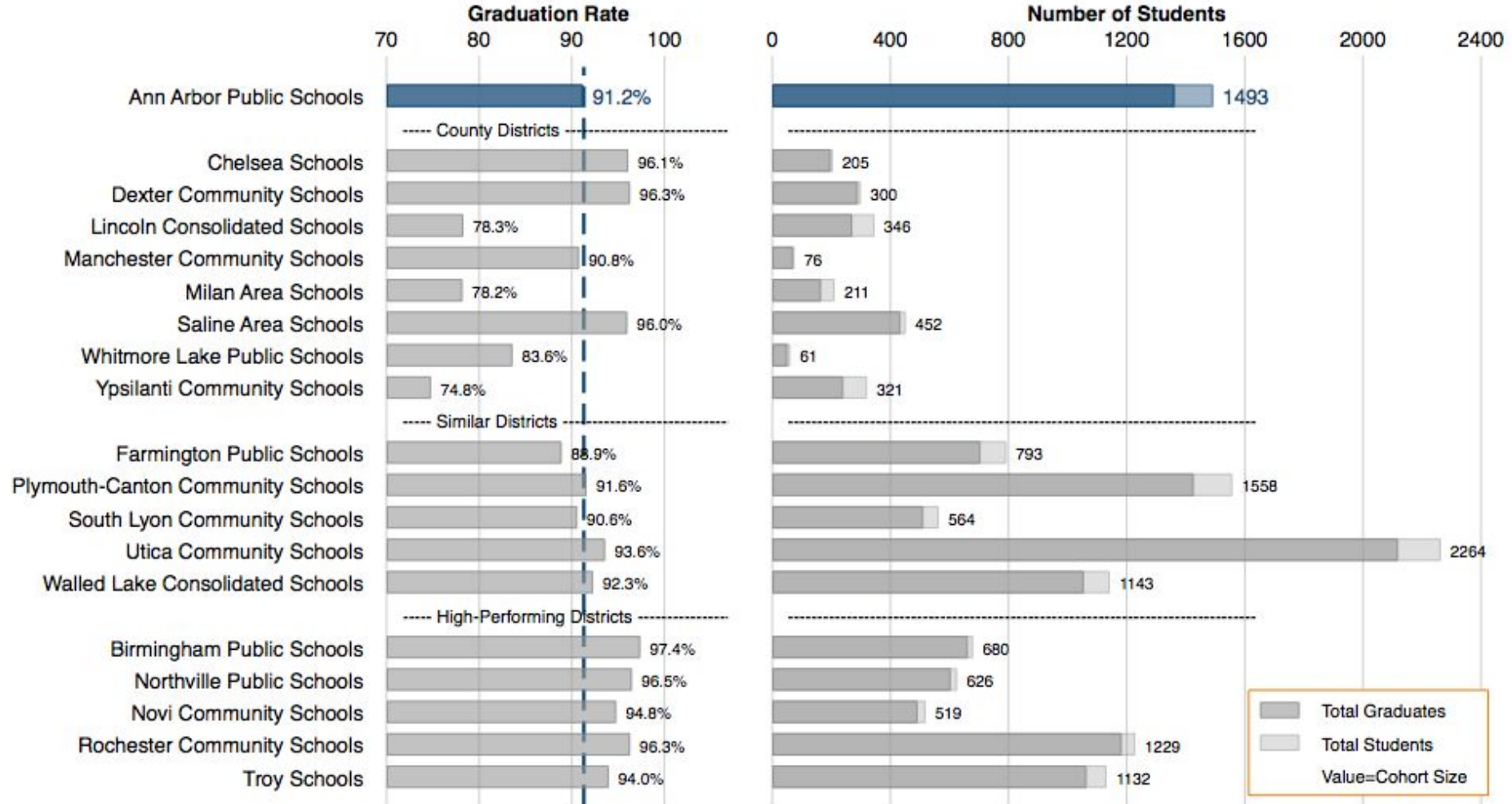

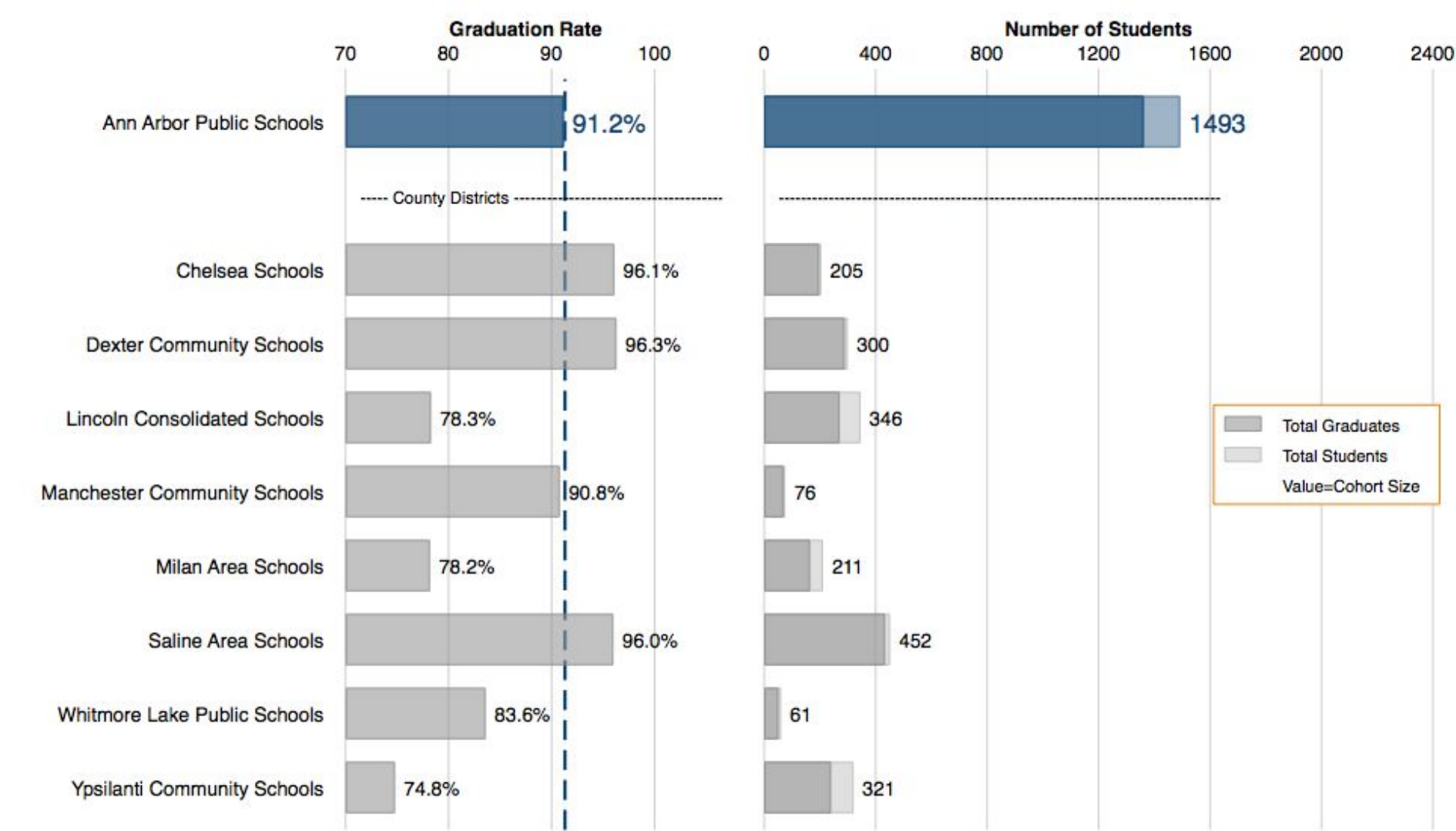
## 4-Year Graduation Rates, Students Graduated, Students in Cohort

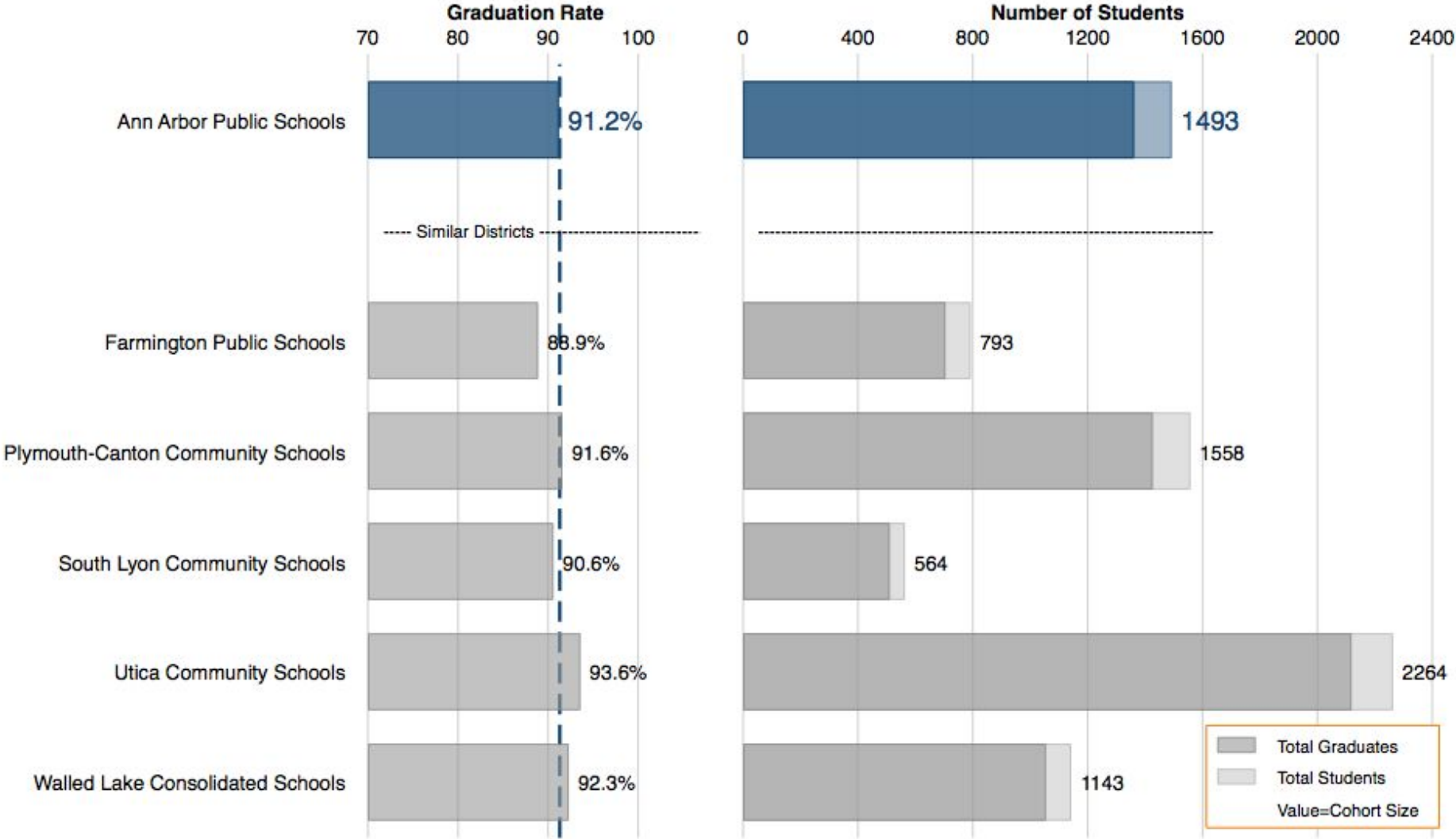
## County Districts 4-Year Graduation Rates, Students Graduated, Students in Cohort

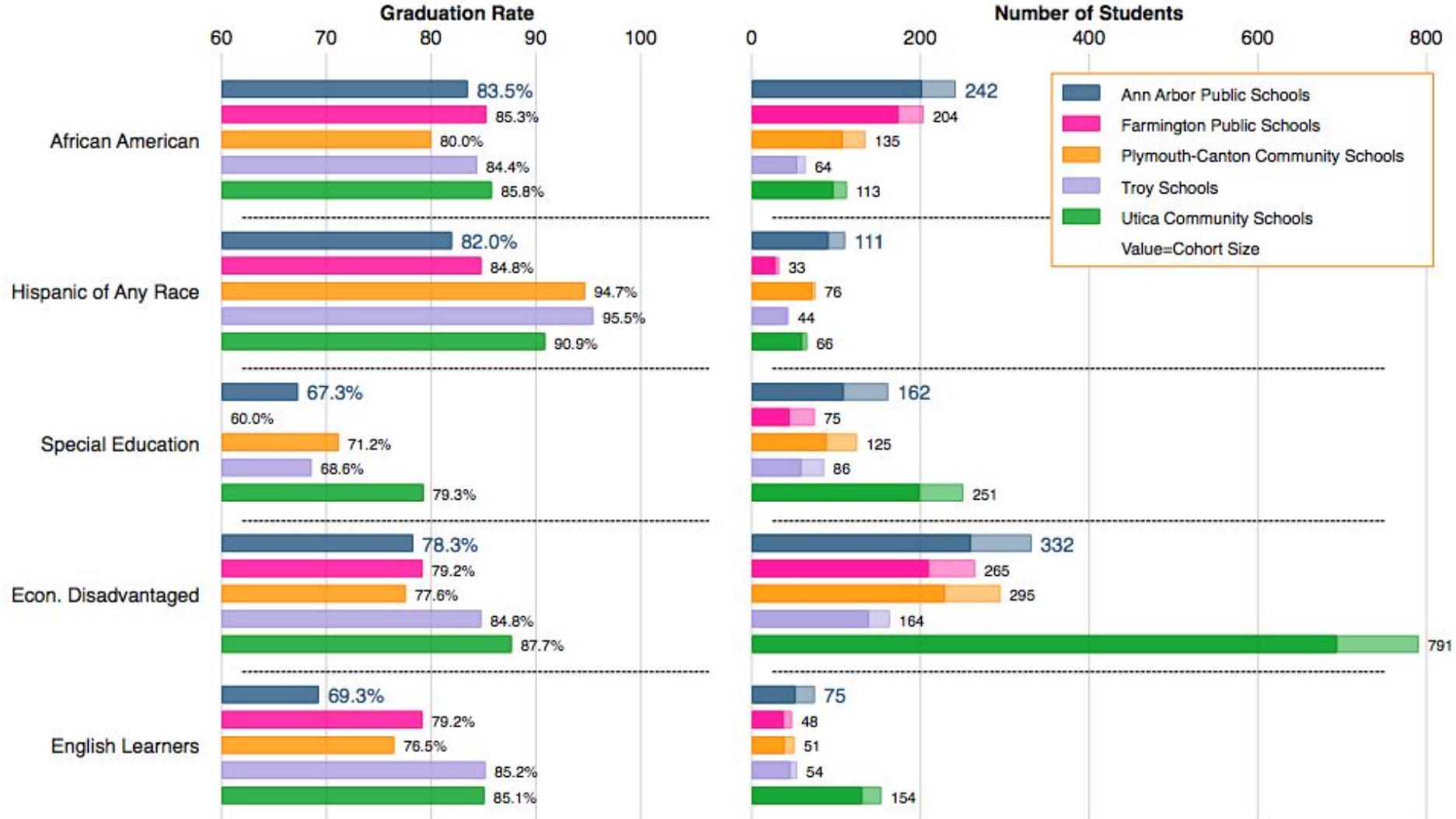

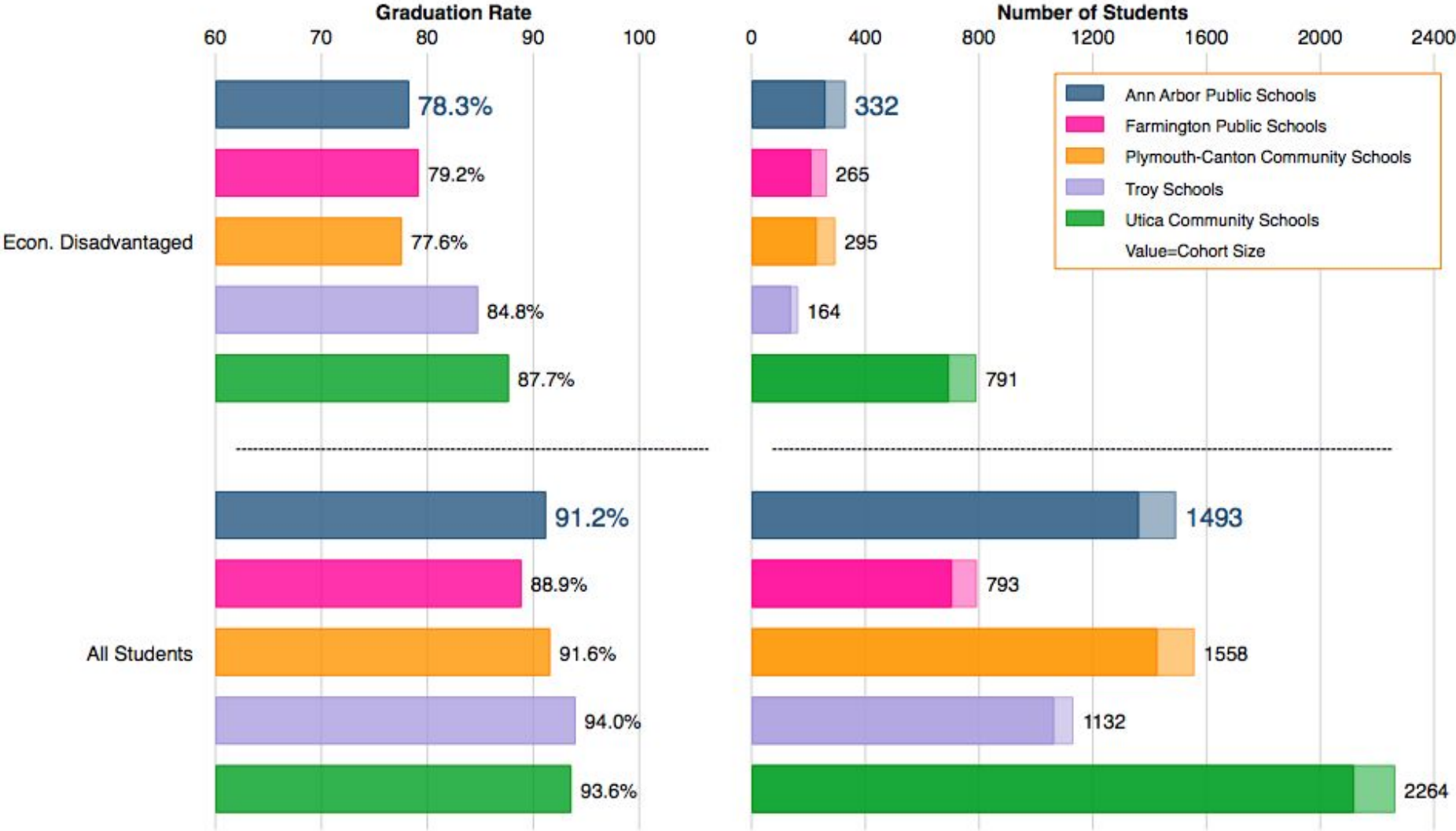

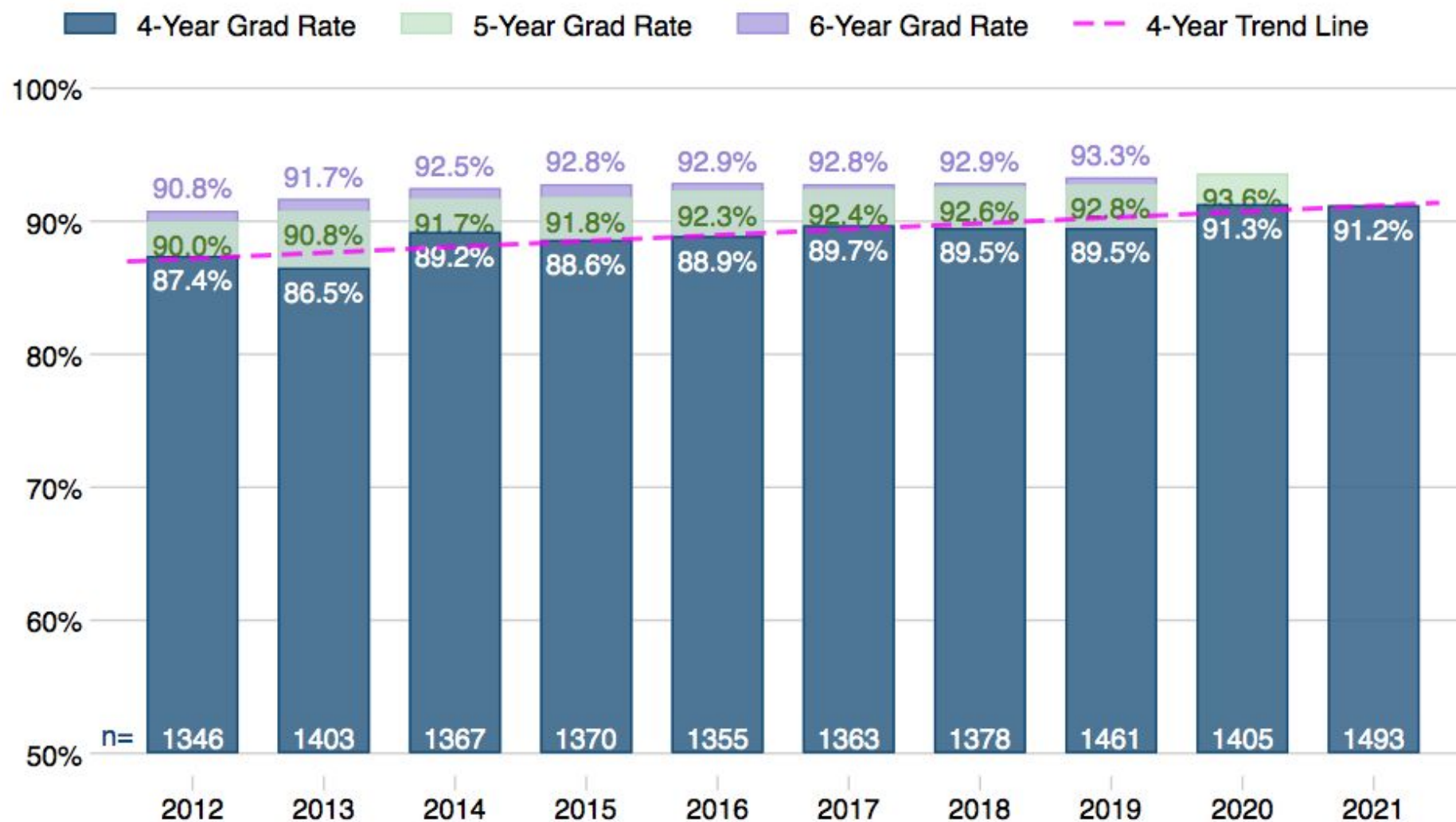

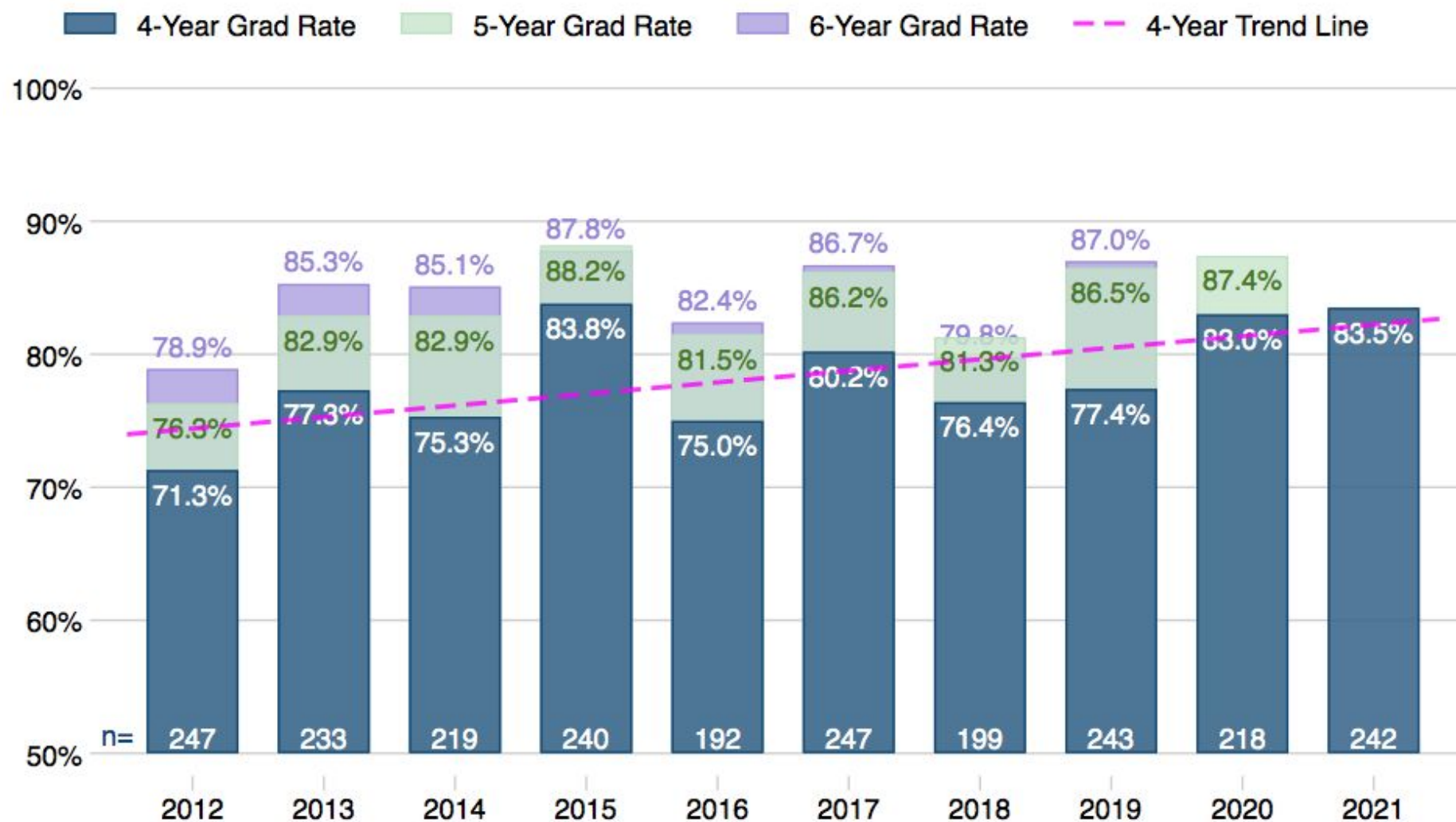

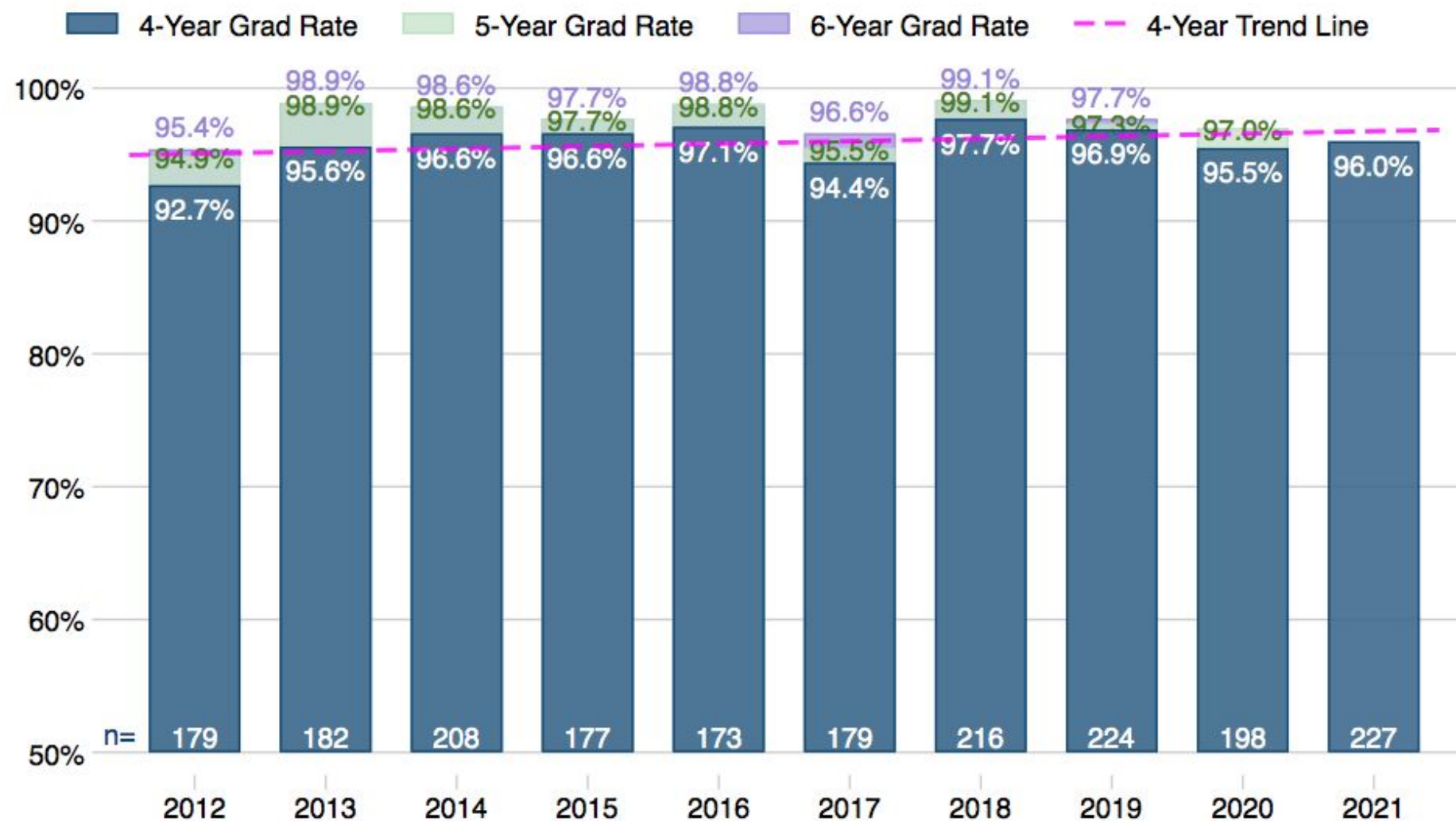

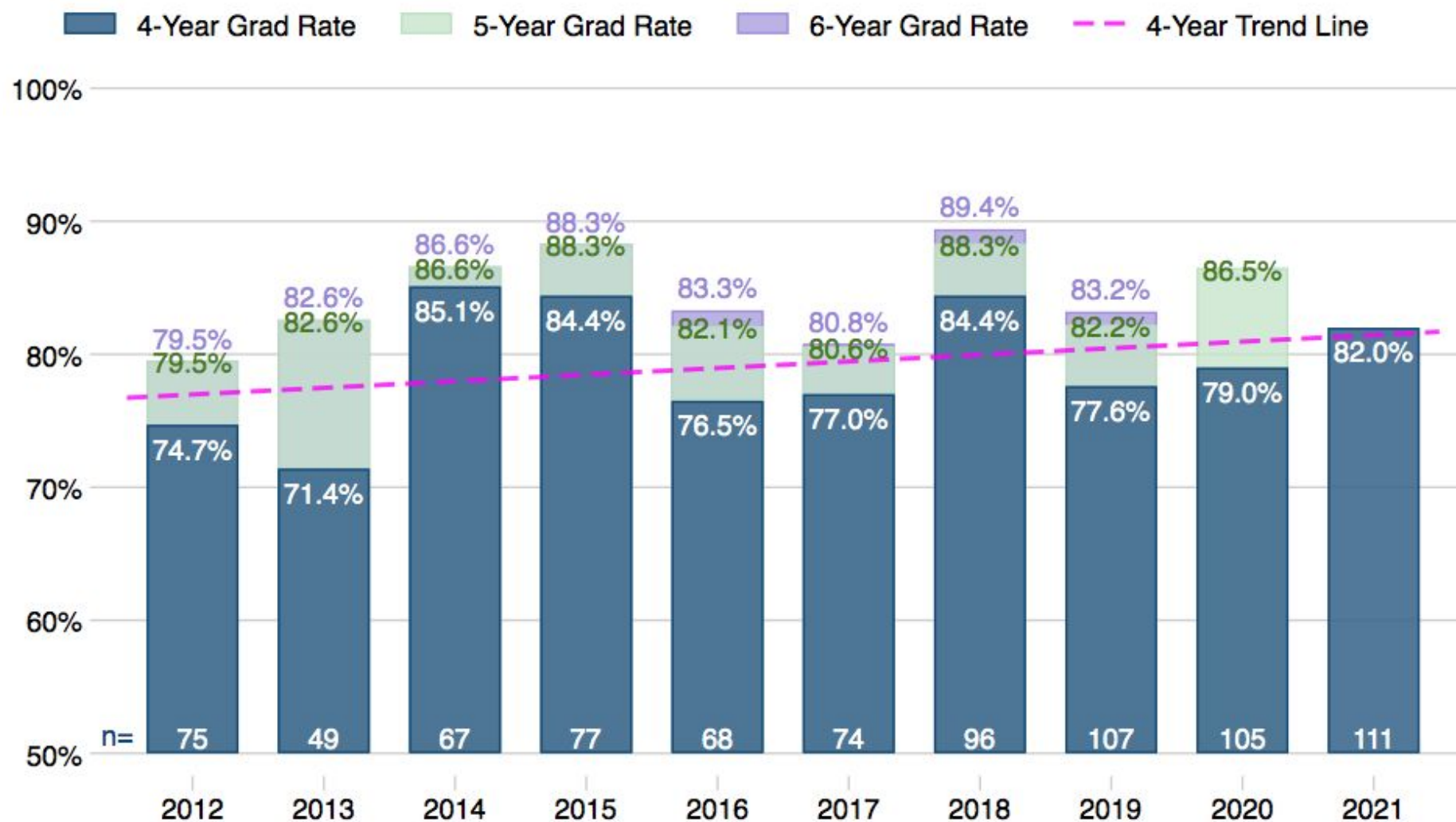

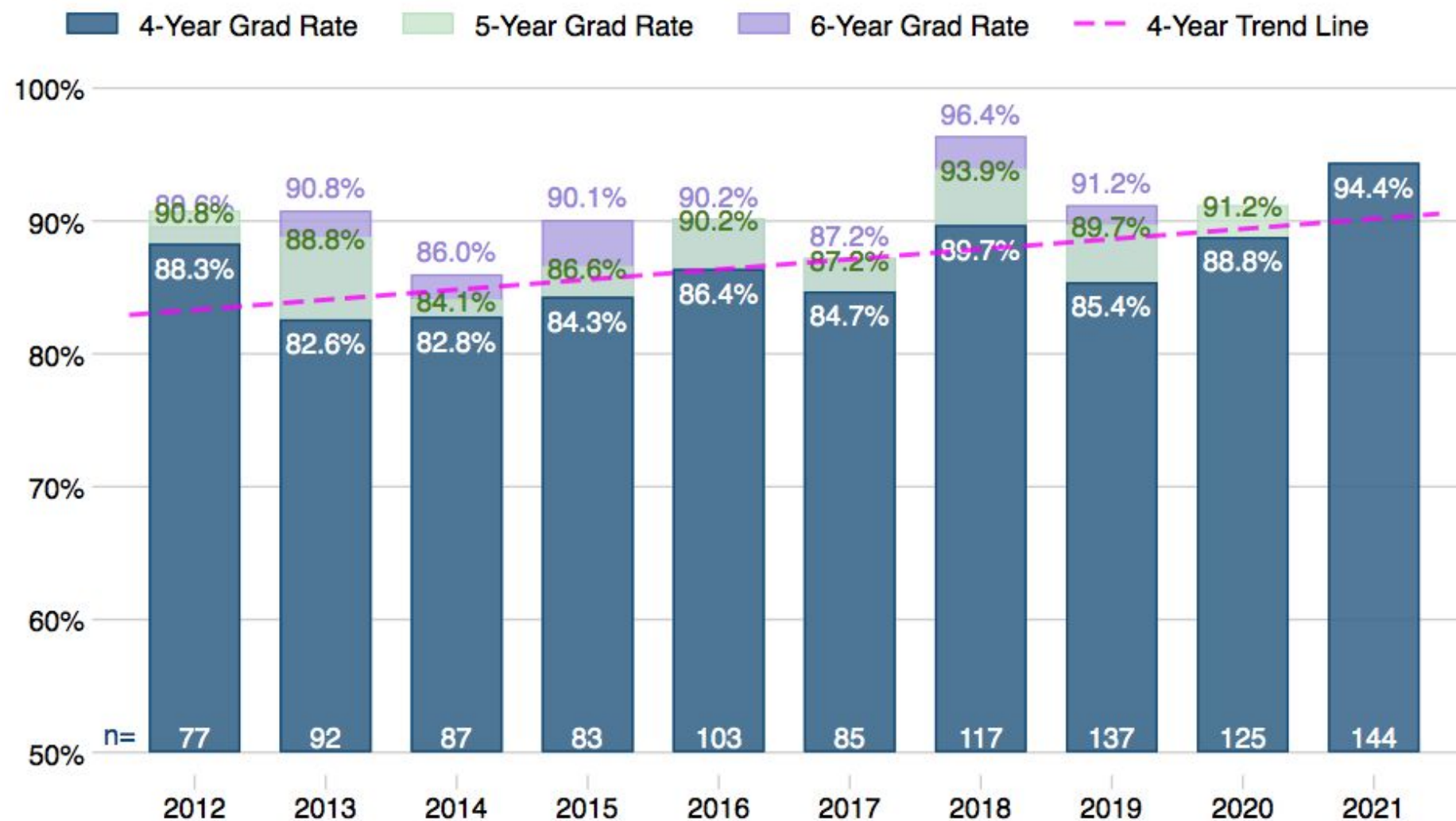

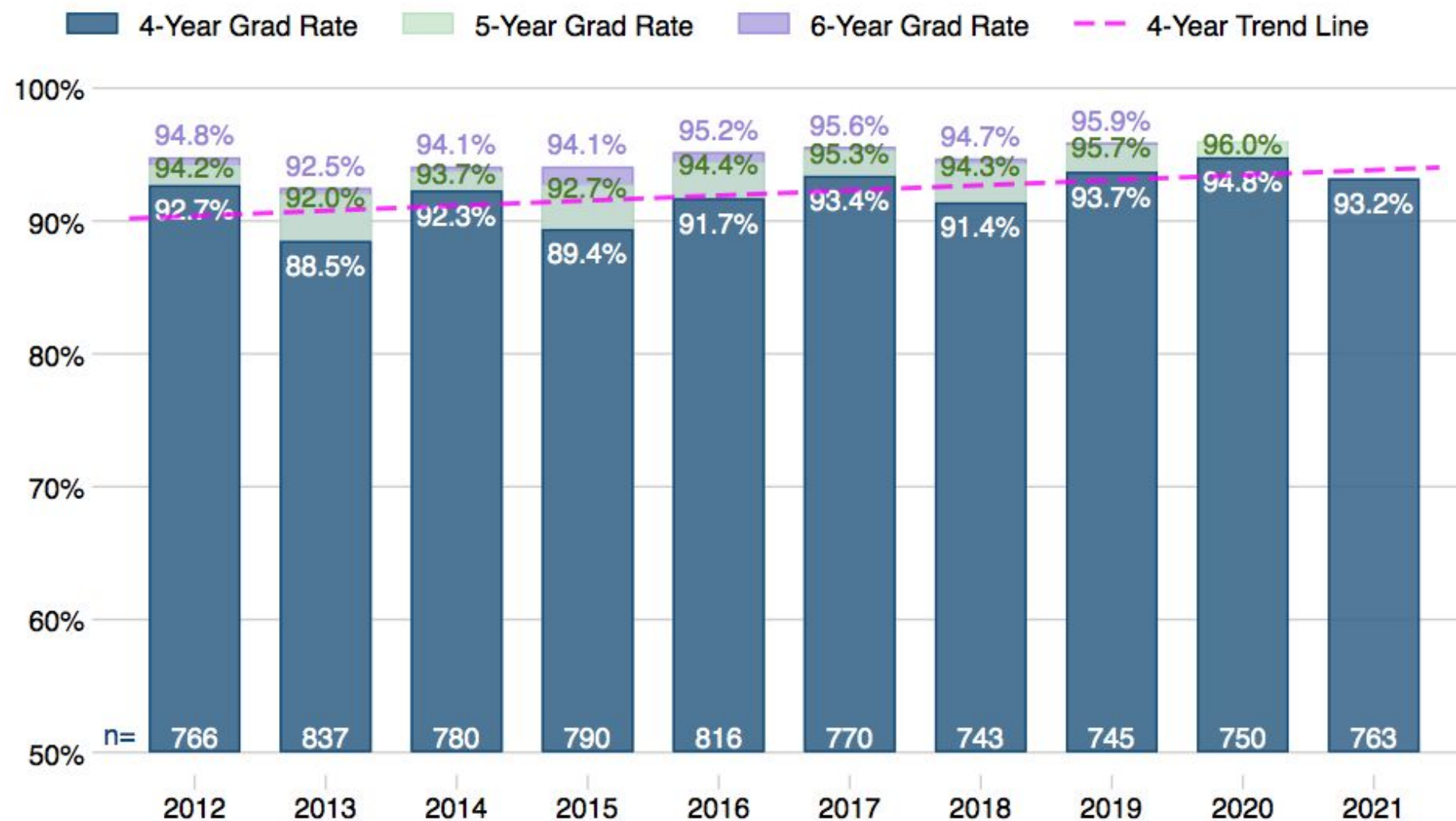

### Two or More Race Students



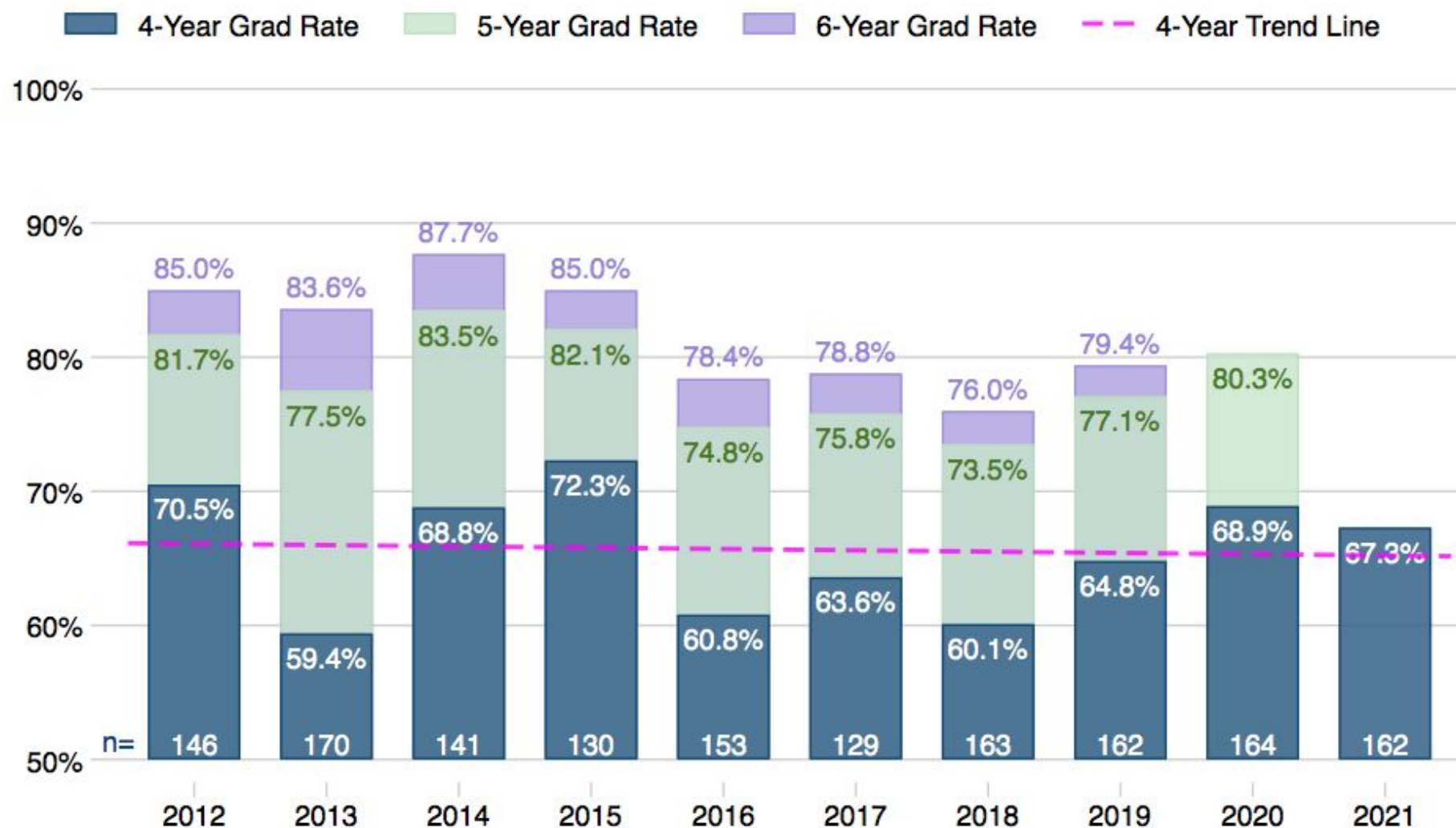

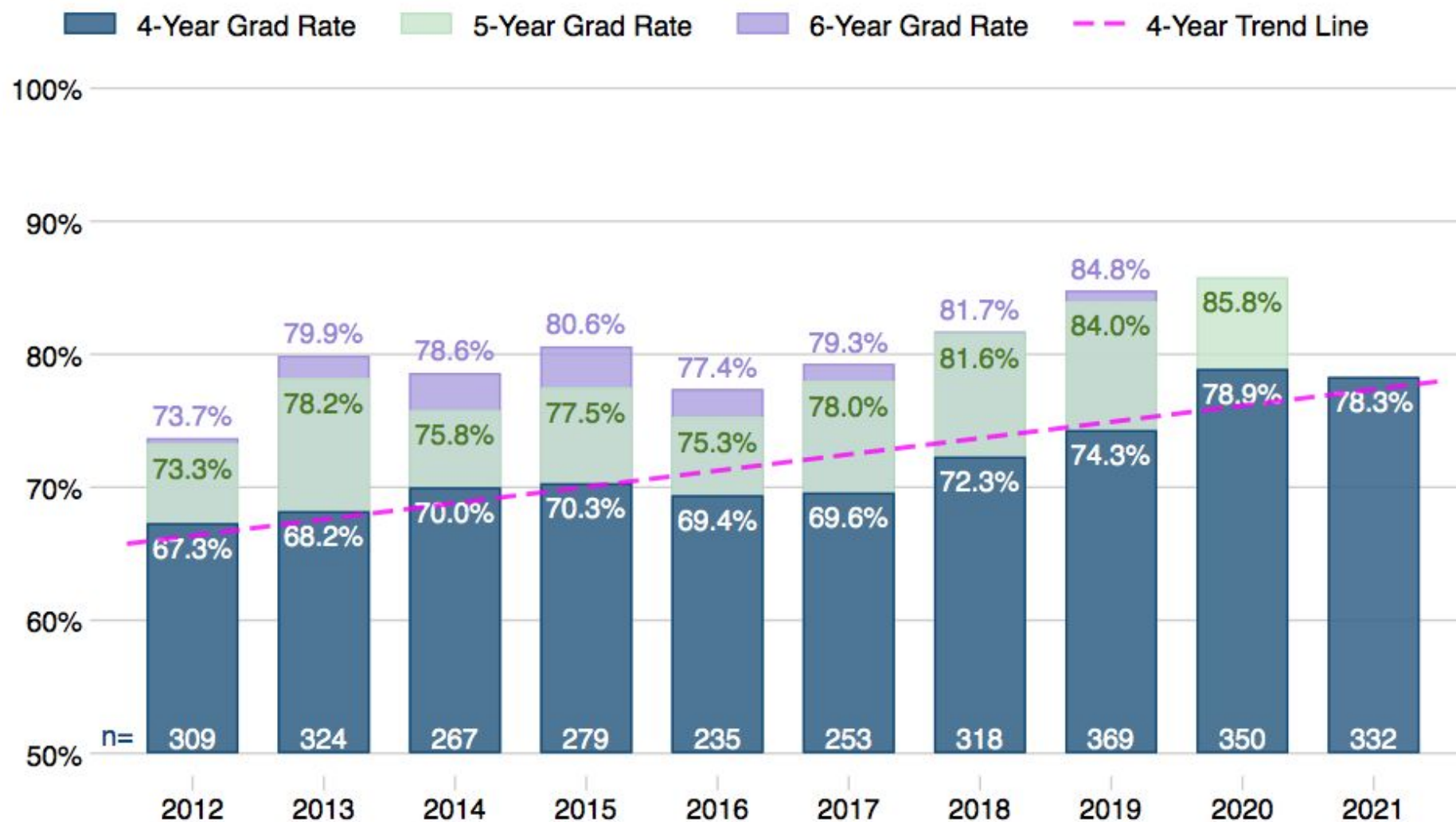

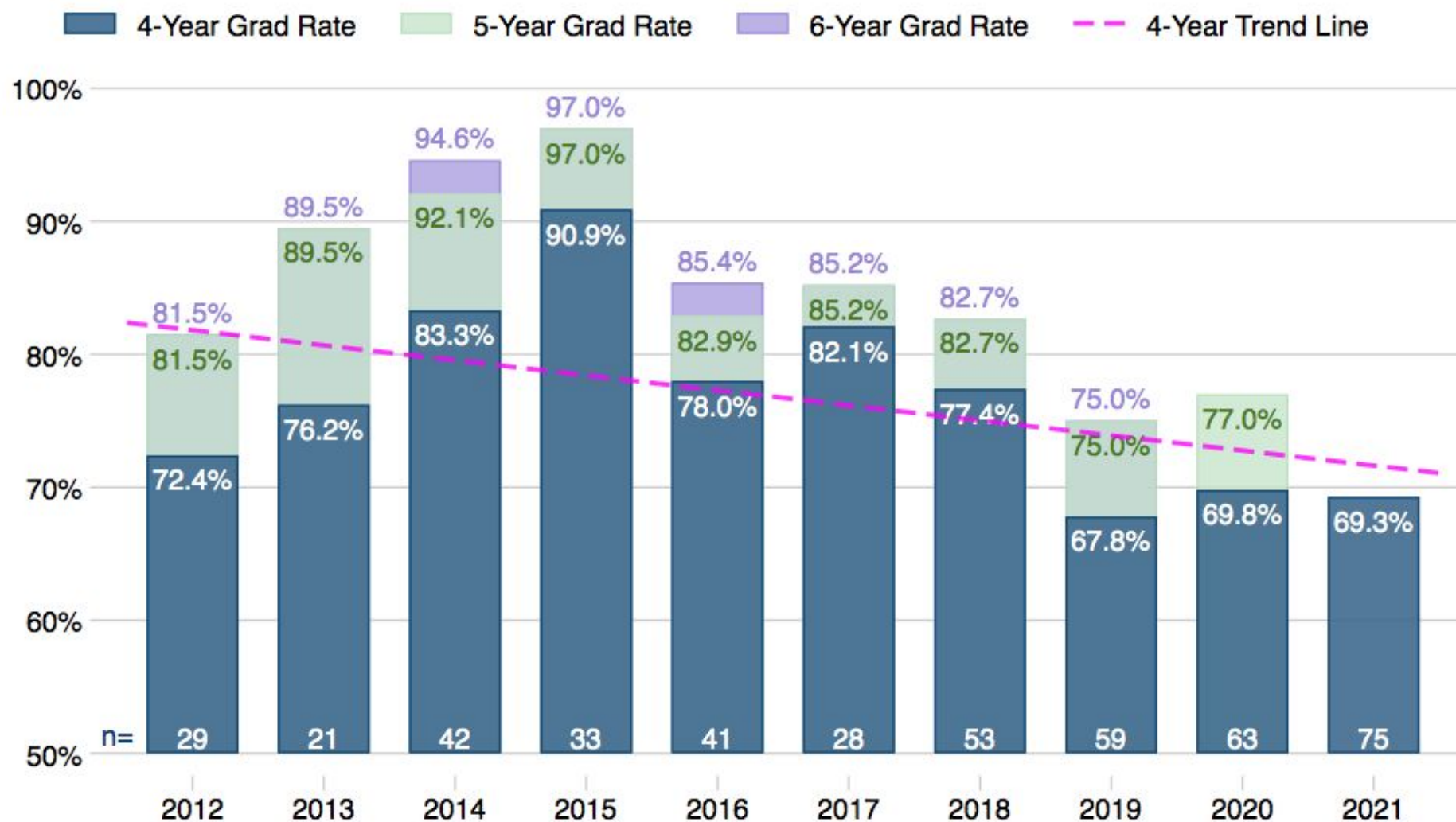

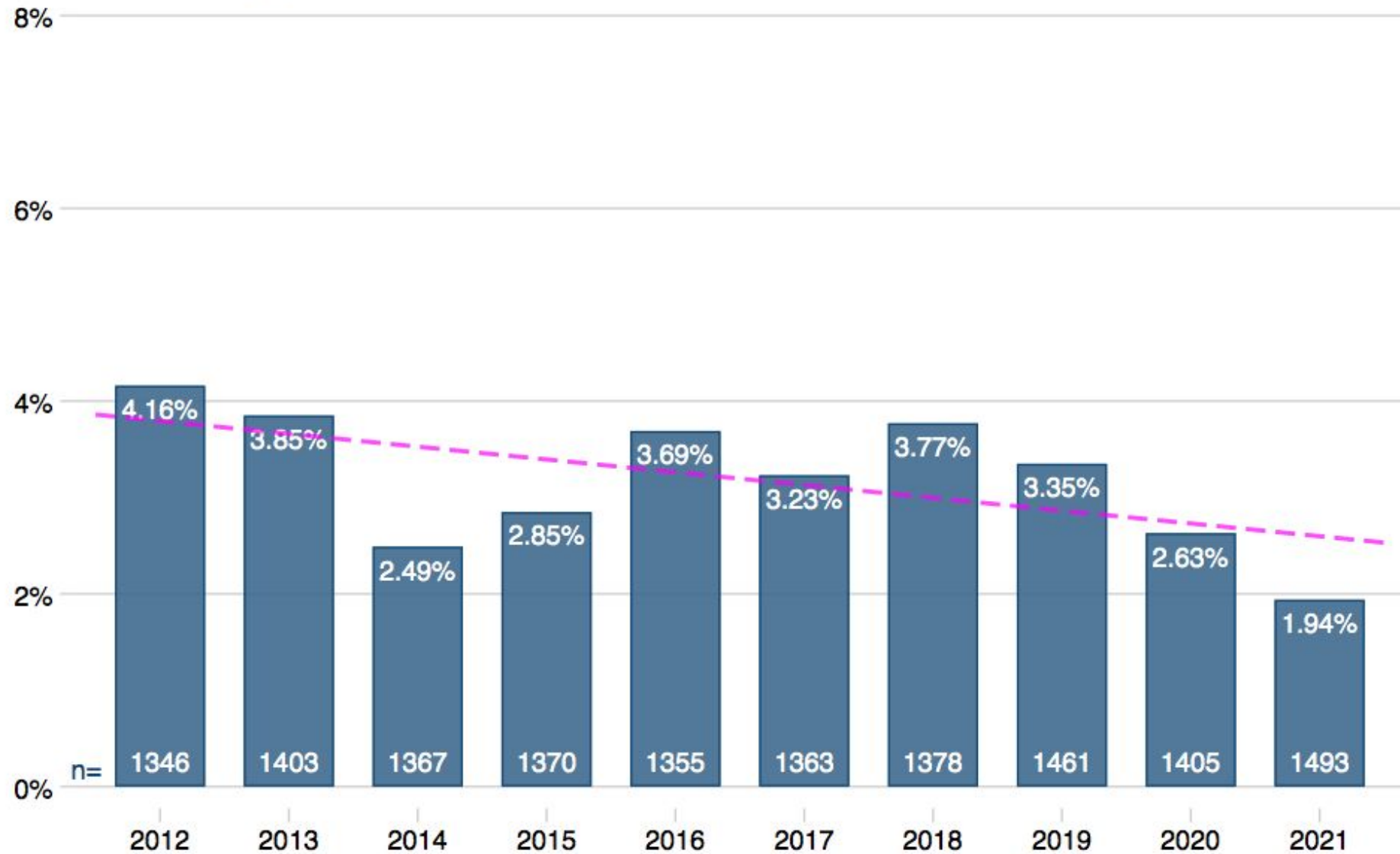


# Evolving Landscape in English Language Learning

In recent years, the AAPS has experienced a **significant increase in both the number and the level of need of English language learners (ELLs).**

- In 2017, the AAPS served **1,472** English Language Learners.
- In 2022, the AAPS now serves **1,747** - **an increase of 275 students (19%)**
- Of 1,747 students, **660 are newcomers**, requiring much higher levels of support
- A growing number of students, (80 currently) enter our doors under the category of **SLIFE, Students with Limited or Interrupted Formal Education**, missing at least 2 years of schooling. The majority of these students enter at grades 6-12.
- Finally, the national average dropout rate for ELLs is 25%, which emphasizes the importance of ensuring robust and ongoing support as students progress through the AAPS toward English proficiency.
