- Integration of **social emotional learning (SEL)**



MS Summer Challenge Focus Standards



➤ Math Focus

- Application of data analysis
- Application of ratio and proportions

➤ Literacy Focus

- Gathering evidence
- Building an argument with evidence
- Presenting evidence



Sample Challenge: Face Masks

- **Problem Statement:** People are required to wear face coverings when entering enclosed, public spaces. However, **resources are limited**. Ordering a face mask can have delays of up to 6 weeks.
- **Design Statement:** In teams, you will design, build, and test a face mask using (and reusing) materials around your home.
 - **Criteria & Constraints:**
 - It must cover mouth and nose.
 - It must have a filter.
 - It must be able to stay on a face without hands touching it.

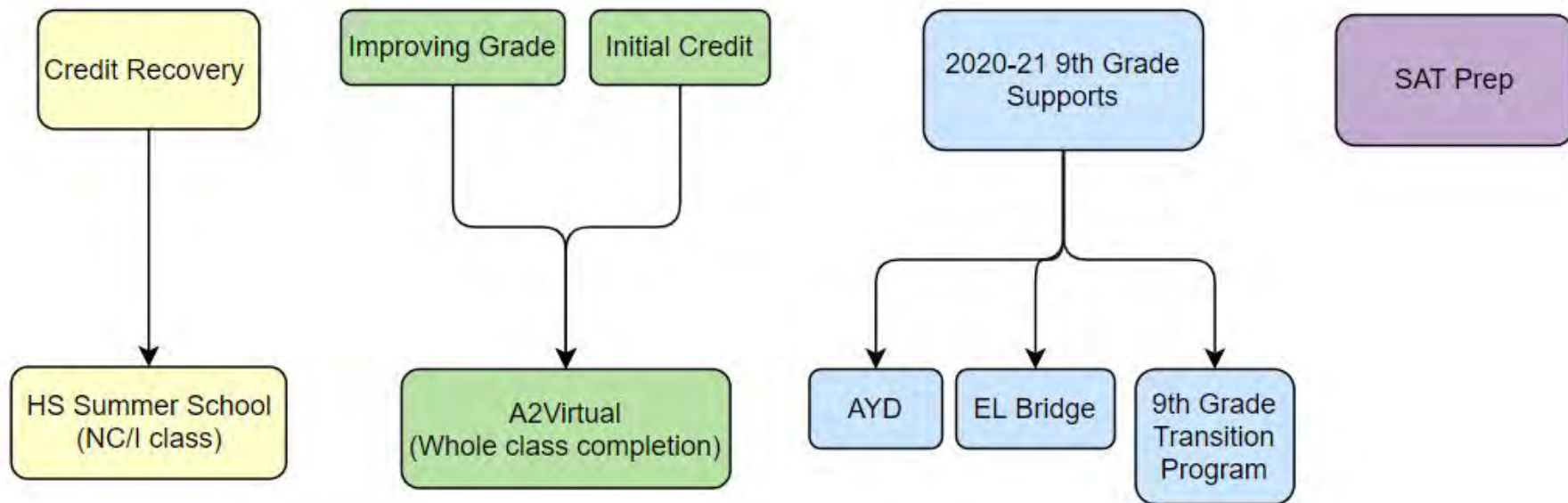

Summer Academy offers all students with IEPs opportunities for targeted instruction and related services in specific areas of need from speech, language and fine motor to social & coping skills.

Intensive Reading Program (IRP) K - 12

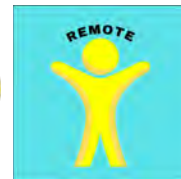
Our Summer Intensive Reading Program focuses on decoding, encoding, and reading comprehension strategies, using multisensory activities. Students are recommended by teachers for this program.

Extended School Year (ESY) PK - 12

Extended School Year services are offered to PK-12 Special Education students with IEPs who were found eligible for services based on criteria set by MDE.

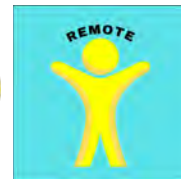
