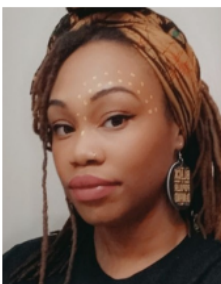

- [Approved AN-2087 Commissioning Services for Capital Improvement Projects](#) – three-year contracts with two optional one-year renewals with Synergy Consulting Engineers Inc., of Belmont, MI, and Strategic Energy Solutions Inc., of Berkley, MI, for commissioning services to be paid from Bond Program Funds and/or the Sinking Fund.
- [Approved AN-2081 Network Equipment Refreshment: Annual E-Rate Application](#) to award Sentinel Technologies of Downers Grove, Illinois, a contract not to exceed \$425,100.00, for the E-Rate Networking hardware, software, maintenance/monitoring and professional services, with funding provided by the Technology Bond Fund with some reimbursement from E-Rate funds.

For contracts as follows:
AN-2082: for the purchase and installation of structural and miscellaneous steel for Bach Elementary School to Morkin and Sowards, Inc., of Wayne, MI, in the amount of \$41,695, plus a contingency of \$4,170, for a total recommended award of \$45,865, to be paid from Bond Program Funds.
AN-2083: for landscaping services at Clague Middle School to KLM Landscape of Armada, MI, in the amount of \$111,869, plus a contingency of \$11,187, for a total recommended award of \$123,056, to be paid from Bond Program Funds.
AN-2084: purchase and installation of structural and miscellaneous steel for the Eberwhite Elementary Air-Conditioning and Lighting Project to Morkin and Sowards, Inc. of Wayne, MI, in the amount of \$30,252, plus a contingency of \$3,025, for a total recommended award of \$33,277, to be paid from Bond Program Funds.
AN-2085: for flooring replacement at Forsythe Middle School to Shock Brothers Floorcovering Inc. of Roseville, MI, in the amount of \$160,500, plus a contingency of \$16,050, for a total recommended award of \$176,550, to be paid from Bond Program Funds.
- [Approved AN-2086 Skyline Stormwater Pumps and Irrigation System Replacement](#) – a contract for the procurement and installation of a new irrigation system, stormwater pumps and accompanying landscaping and earthwork at Skyline High School with American Sprinkler of Livonia, MI, in the amount of \$321,400; Progressive Irrigation, Inc. of Clarkston, MI, in the amount of \$124,101; and Kennedy Industries of Wixom, MI, in the amount of \$81,400; plus, a 15% contingency of \$79,035, for a total recommended amount of \$605,936, to be paid from the Bond Program Funds.
- [Approved AN-2088 Pioneer High School Audio/Visual Equipment and Theatrical Lighting Replacement](#) – a contract for procurement and installation of audio/visual equipment and lighting systems with Advanced Lighting & Sound Inc., of Troy, MI, in the amount of \$1,237,540, plus a contingency of \$123,754, for a total recommended award of \$1,361,294, to be paid from the Bond Program Funds.
